

Introduced by the City Council

A RESOLUTION HONORING OFFICER JOHN HEGE AND EXTENDING OUR SINCERE AND DEEPEST SYMPATHIES AND CONDOLENCES TO HIS FAMILY, FRIENDS AND CO-WORKERS

WHEREAS, Officer John Hege, 41 years old, was a ten-year veteran of the City of Oakland Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Officer Hege is described by his friends and co-workers as “outgoing and friendly, an honest and fair-minded man who loved helping others and being part of a team;” and

WHEREAS, as a member of the Motorcycle Division, colleagues say that Officer Hege was always the first to respond on the radio to assist other officers or to help on a project; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2009 Officer Hege tragically lost his life while in the line of duty, protecting the citizens of Oakland; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that I, Jane Brunner, City Council President, on behalf of the entire Council of the City of Oakland, hereby honor Sergeant John Hege for faithfully performing his public duty to protect and serve the citizens of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that on behalf of our city, its employees and its citizens, we extend our sincere and deepest sympathies and condolences to Sergeant John Hege’s family, his friends and co-workers.
