RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, SEX OFFENDER SENTENCING, MONITORING, APPREHENDING, REGISTERING, AND TRACKING (SMART) OFFICE, FISCAL YEAR 2007 SUPPORT FOR ADAM WALSH ACT IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 2, 2008 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2009, AND APPROPRIATE SAID FUNDS TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO INCREASE STAFFING ASSIGNED TO SEX OFFENDER REGISTRATION, TRACKING AND COMPLIANCE

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering, and Tracking (SMART) Office, shall award the City of Oakland grant in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 to support the Oakland Police Department's implementation of the Fiscal Year 2007 Support for Adam Walsh Act Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the SMART grant program was developed to assist jurisdictions with developing and/or enhancing programs designed to implement the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) under the Adam Walsh Act; and

WHEREAS, the Adam Walsh Act (AWA) (42 U.S.C. § 16901, et seq.) is designed to protect children and other vulnerable adults from sexual exploitation and violent crime, prevent child abuse and child pornography, promote Internet safety, and honor the memory of Adam Walsh and other crime victims; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to support the Police Department's efforts to enhance the services of the Department's Special Victims Unit by adding staff assigned to sex offender registration, tracking and compliance; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That said grant shall be appropriated to and maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Youth and Family Services Division Org.: 102350; Youth and Family Services Division Program: PS03; in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$300,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering, and Tracking (SMART) Office to the Oakland Police Department, and to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant.
