RESOLUTION APPROVING THE INSTALLATION OF ALL-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF RUDSDALE STREET WITH 79TH AND 81ST AVENUES

WHEREAS, residents near the first-year Woodland Charter School along with ACORN (Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now) requested by petition the installation of all-way stop signs at the intersections of Rudsdale Street and 79th Avenue (southern intersection) and Rudsdale Street and 81st Avenue, and
