RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND APPROPRIATE UP TO FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S HOMELAND SECURITY OVERTIME PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) is soliciting proposals from qualified local law enforcement agencies for the designated purpose of affording additional officer overtime funds to support community policing and homeland security efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Department is eligible to petition for up to five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) in Federal grant funds through this initiative; and

WHEREAS, a local cash match of twenty-five percent (25%) of the total amount requested is required and must be made from local, state or other non-COPS funds and may not be paid through the reallocation of funds otherwise budgeted for specific law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, matching funds proposed for the Homeland Security Overtime Program will be appropriated to the Police Department's General Purpose Fund Baseline if the City Manager's Proposed Budget for FY 2003-05 is adopted by the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant does not cover Central Services Overhead charges in the amount of \$58,050, and the Department has requested a waiver of said charges; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager or his designee to apply for, accept and appropriate up to \$500,000 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services Homeland Security Overtime Program, to the Oakland Police Department, and to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant.
