

RESOLUTION NAMING THE RAILROAD BICYCLE PATH EXTENDING FROM MOUNTAIN BOULEVARD TO CORTEREAL AVENUE "THE FRANK UDOVCH KEY BICYCLE PATH" IN HONOR OF FRANK UDOVCH'S CONTRIBUTIONS

WHEREAS, City Council has received a request from Assemblymember Audie Bock to name the bicycle path that runs along the old Sacramento Northern Railroad line from Mountain Boulevard to Cortereal Avenue in the memory of Frank Udovch; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Udovch was an ardent bicyclist who was instrumental in the development of bicycle racing teams for Oakland citizens of all ages; and

WHEREAS, the bicycle path along the former railroad bed was a favorite path for Mr. Udovch; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Udovch lost his life on October 9, 1999 in a tragic accident involving the sport he so loved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council also wishes to acknowledge the path as a former railroad right of way and an important part of our transportation history and thus to include a reference in the name to the key system; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Council designates the bicycle path along the former railroad right of way from Mountain Boulevard to Cortereal Avenue in Oakland the "Frank Udovch Key Bicycle Path."


