

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$329,700) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety shall award the City of Oakland grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$329,700 to support the Oakland Police Department's implementation of the fiscal year 2010 Selective Traffic Enforcement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program is geared toward offsetting the incidents of reckless driving and exhibitions of speed commonly referred to as Sideshows and Street Racing, perpetrated by unlicensed and impaired drivers that plague the City of Oakland and the greater San Francisco Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, the Selective Traffic Enforcement Program is designed to employ law enforcement and other innovative strategies to reduce the number of persons killed and injured in traffic collisions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 81223 C.M.S., dated April 15, 2008, Resolution No. 81708 C.M.S., dated December 9, 2008, Resolution No. 80578 C.M.S., dated May 15, 2007, and Resolution Number 80130 C.M.S., dated September 19, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the proposed grant does not allow for indirect costs (Central Services Overhead) charges in the amount of \$41,193, and the Department has requested a waiver of said charges; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to support the Police Department's efforts to enhance the services of the Department's Strategic Area Command Division; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$329,700 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said grant shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund (2999), Strategic Area Command Division Org. (107510), Traffic Division Program (PS14), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That Central Services Overhead costs in the amount of \$41,193 (13.64%) are hereby waived; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate grant funds in an amount not to exceed \$329,700 from the State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, to the Oakland Police Department, and to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant.
