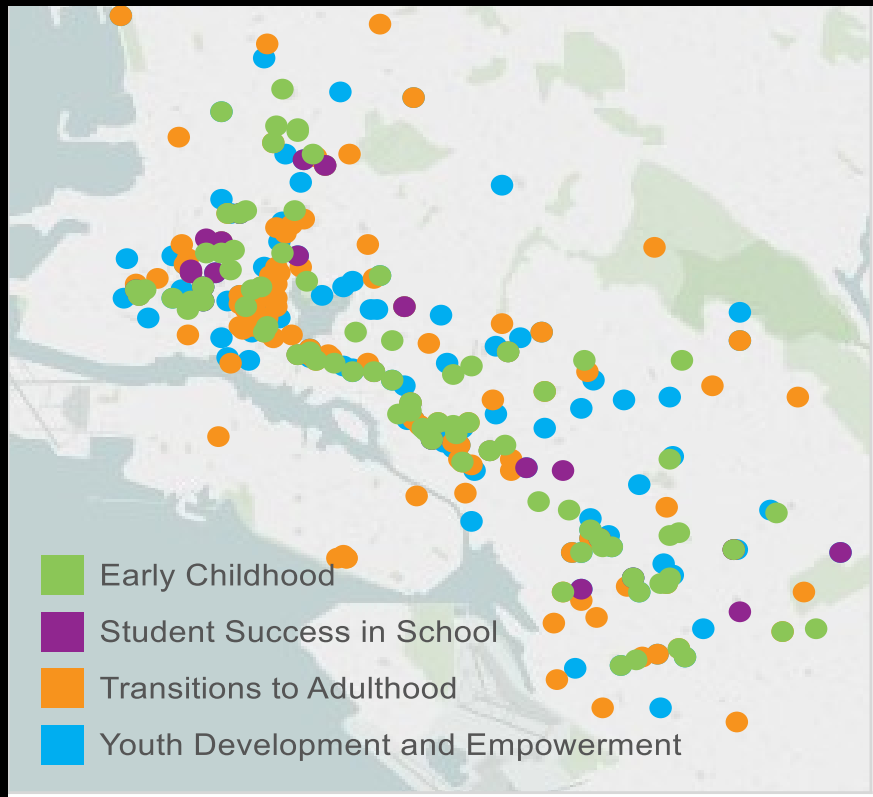

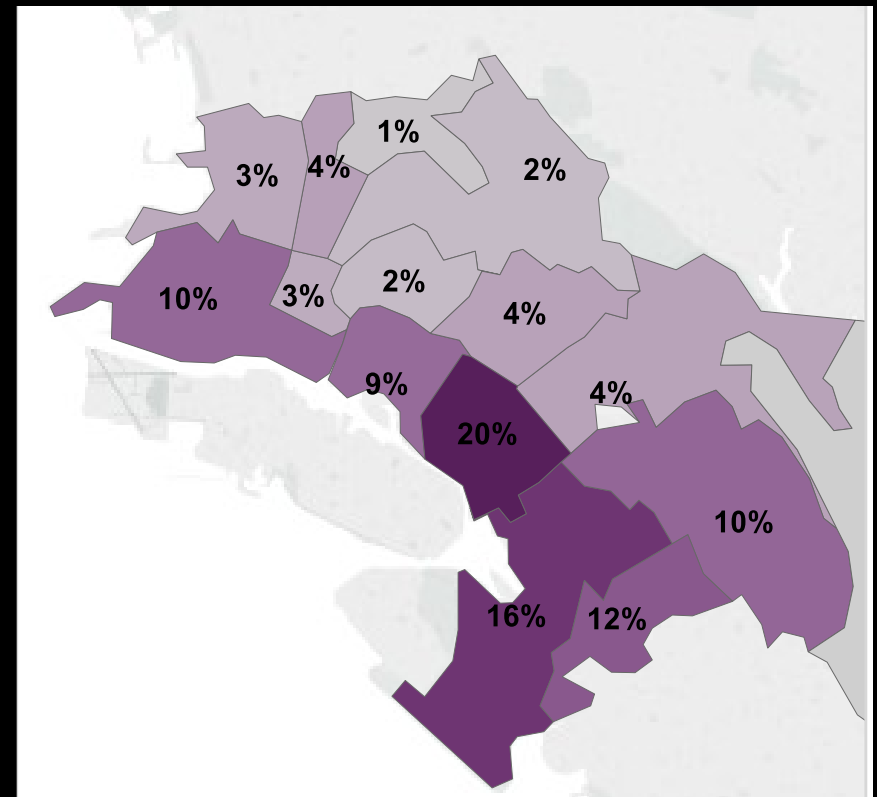
Overview of Participants/Programs

Program Location

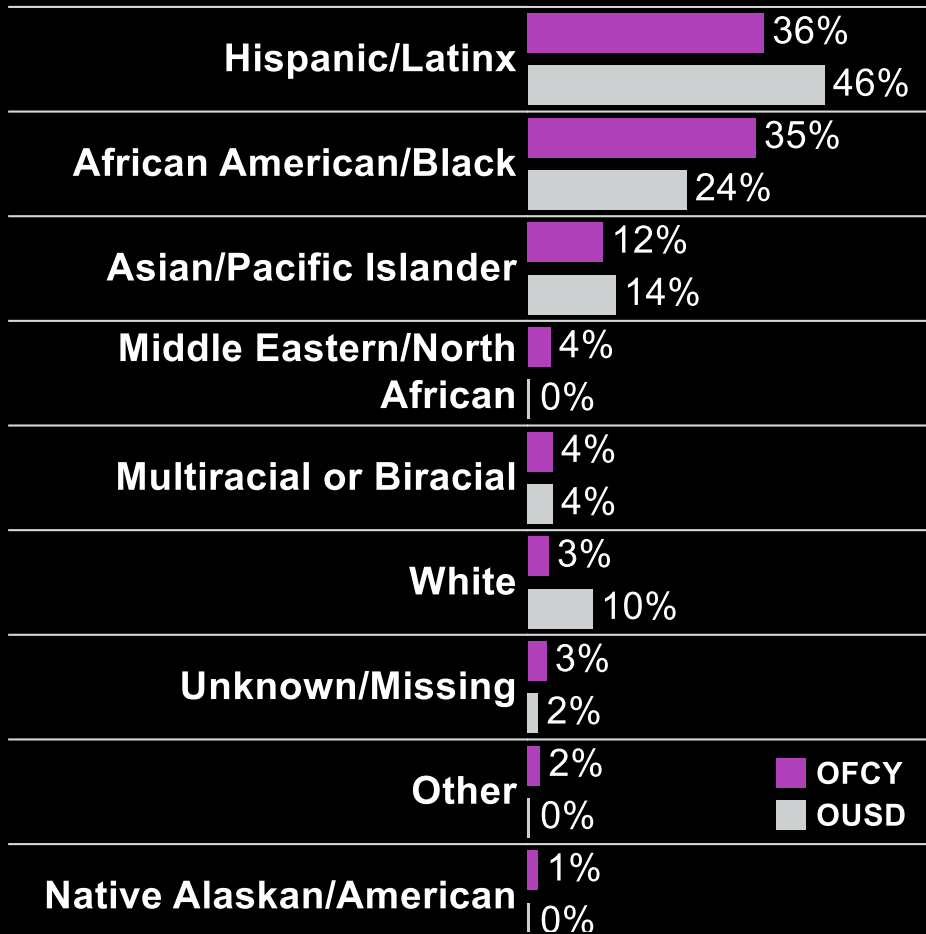


Participant Residence

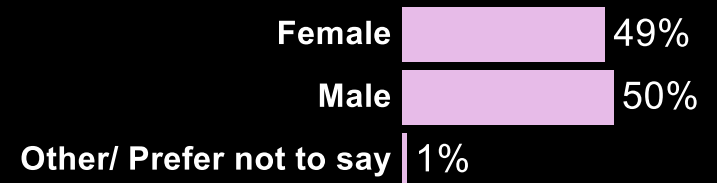


Overview of Youth Participants

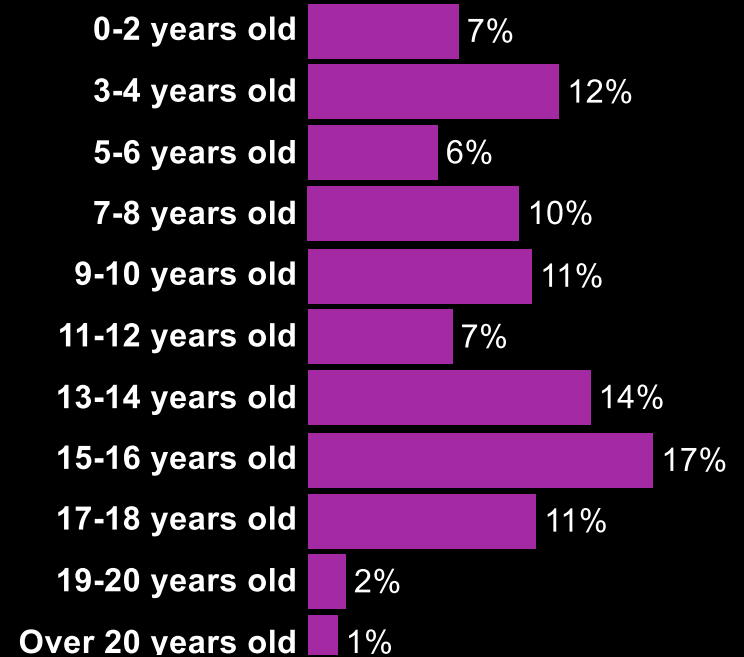
Ethnicity

Parent Support and Engagement

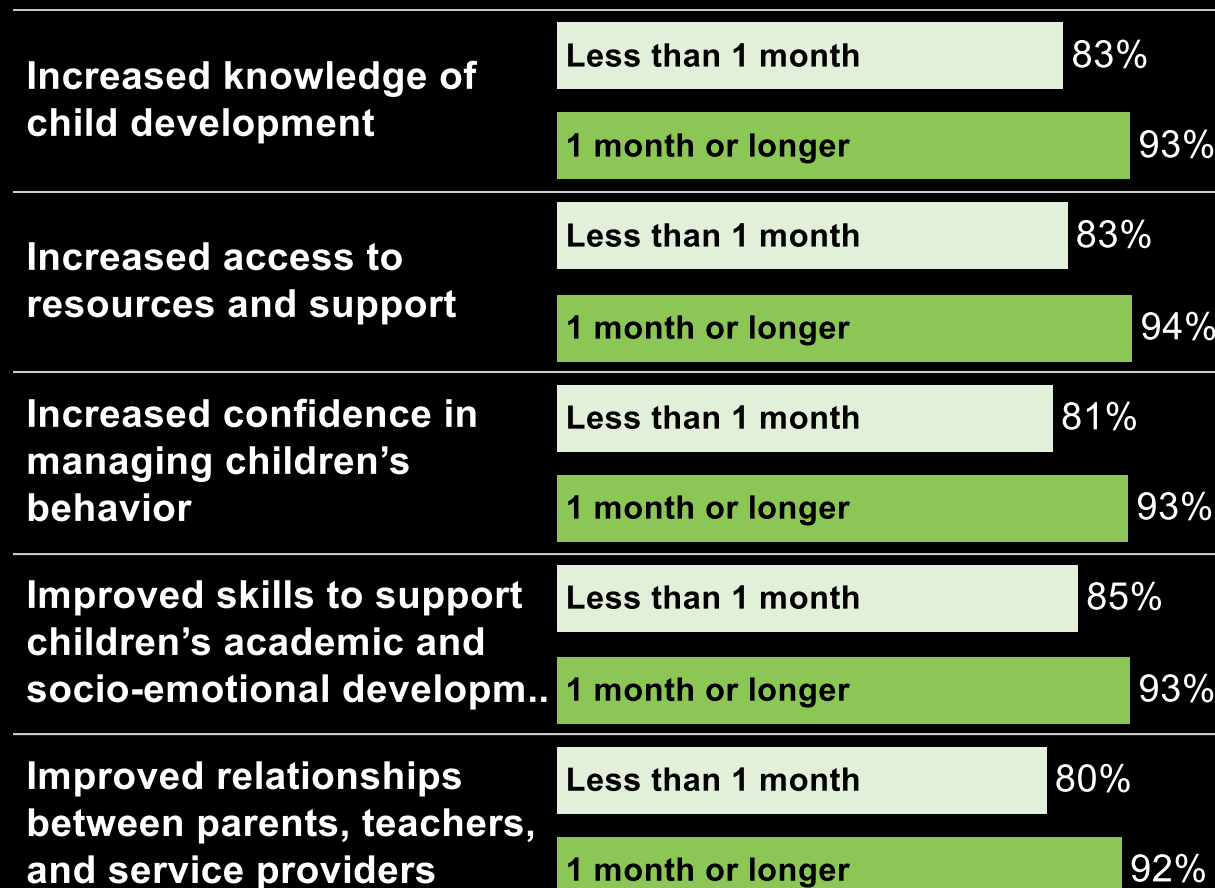


“We're learning to parent in a different way than how we were parented... **A positive way of parenting** instead of just yelling at your child and letting your child yell at you.”

Student Engagement in Learning



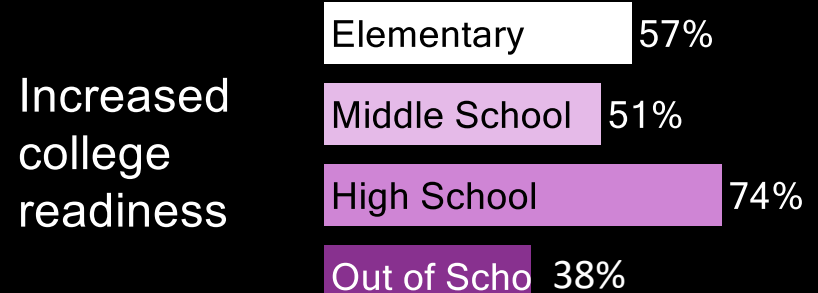
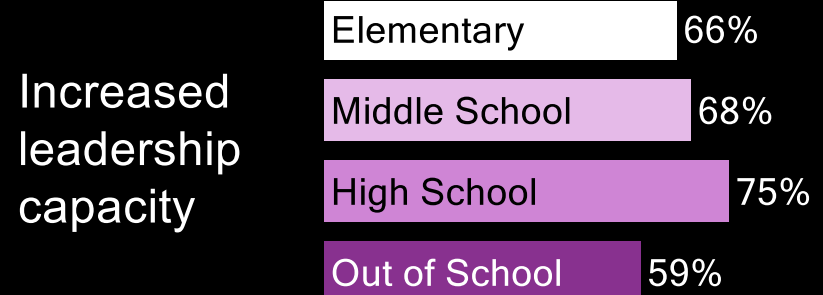
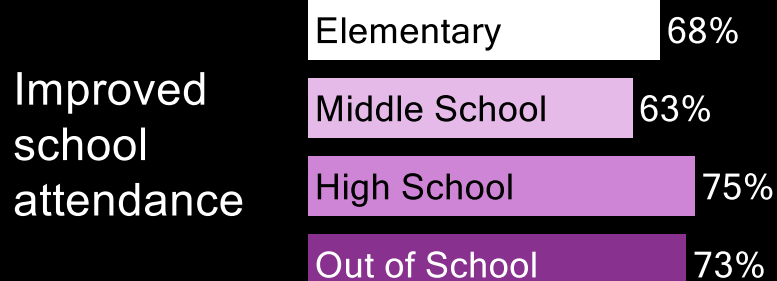
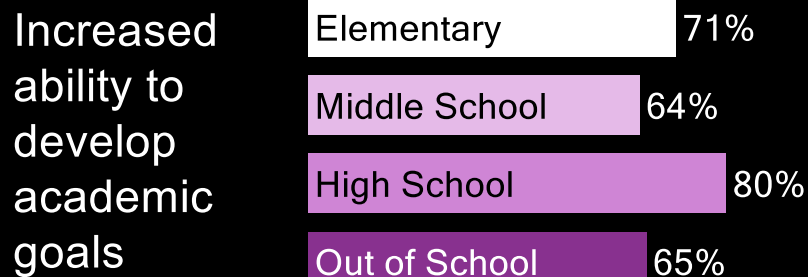
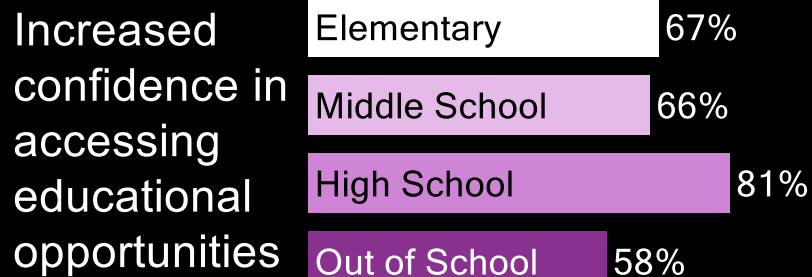

Summer Youth Development and Empowerment

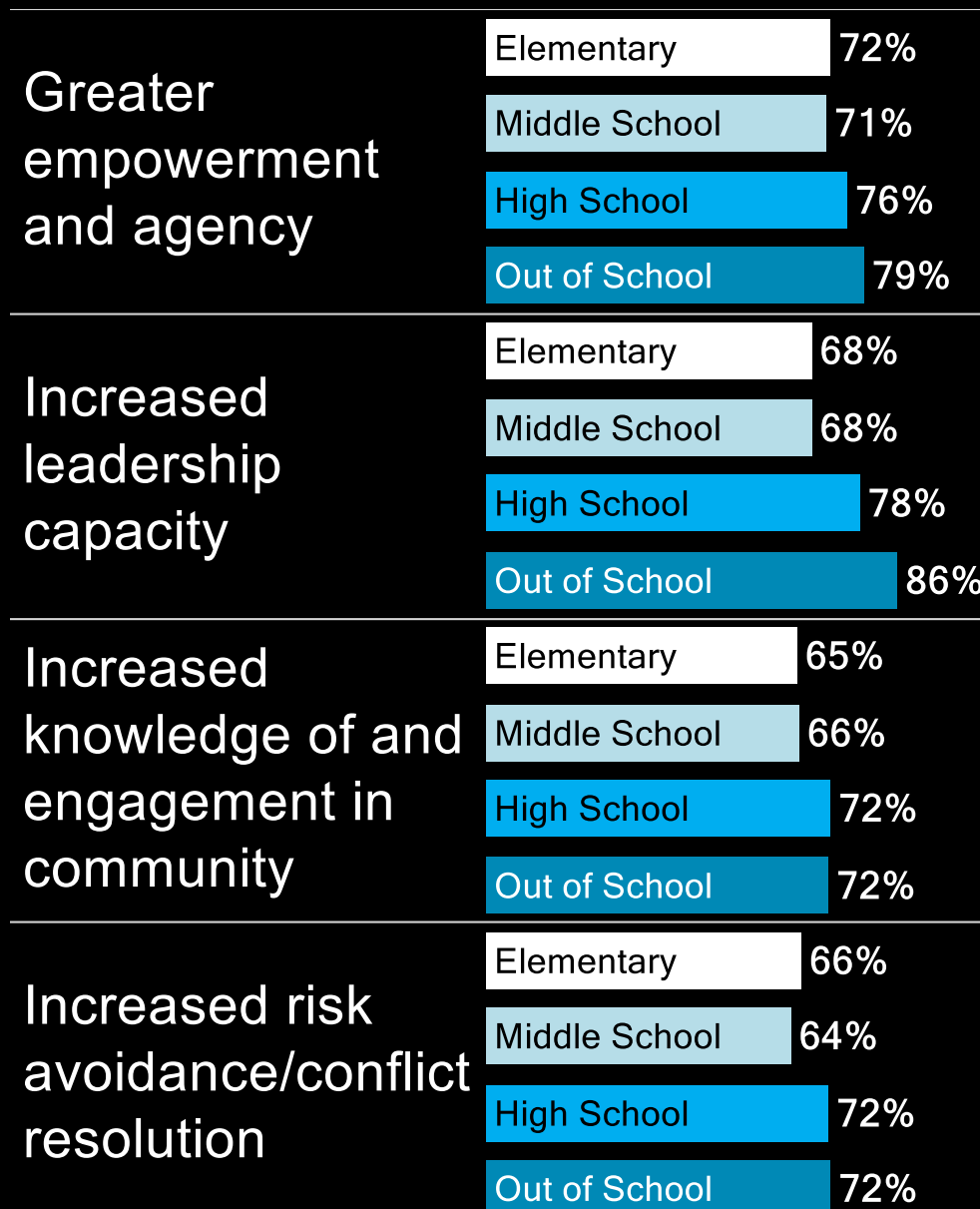

Year-Round Youth Dev. & Empowerment

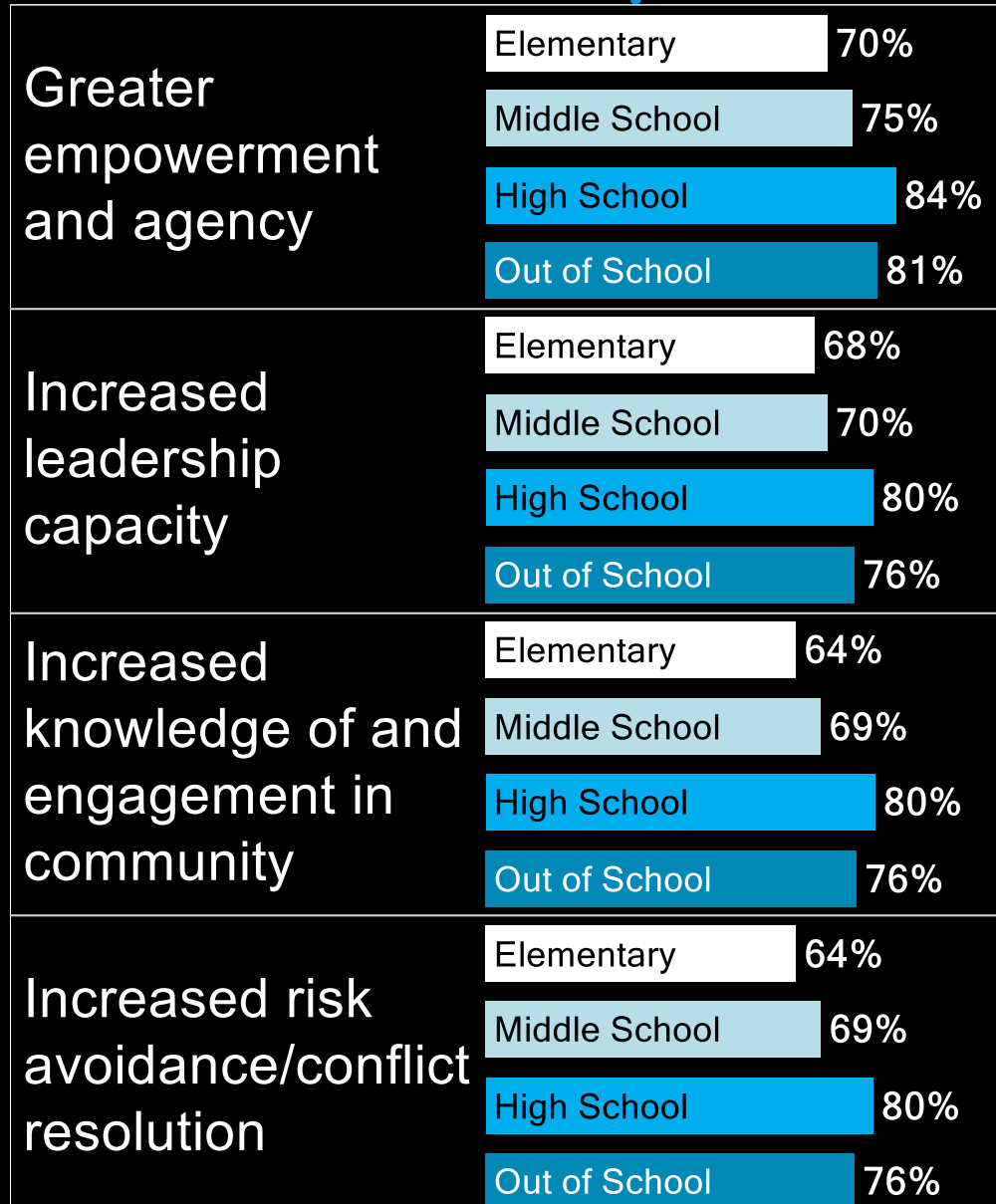


“This program is the only constant thing in my life...The chaos is blocked once the [program] door closes.”

For career awareness outcomes, youth reported the highest progress in increased professionalism.

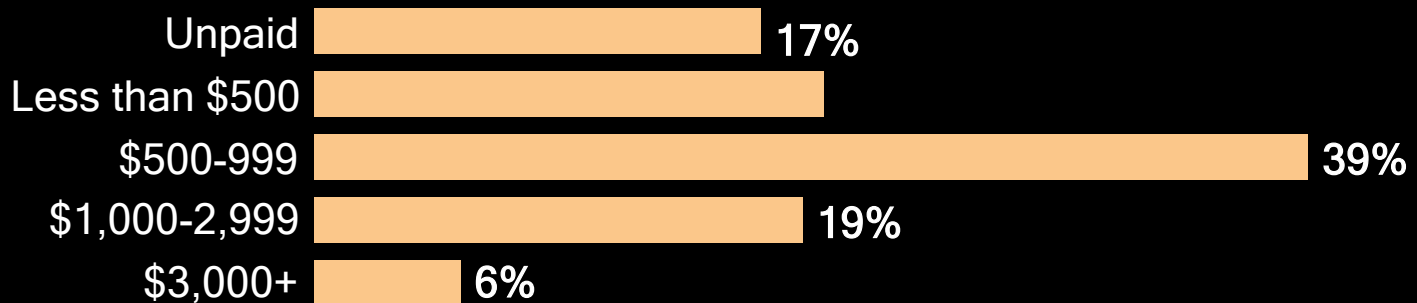
Career Awareness and Academic Support Outcomes
