RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, SERVING AS THE FISCAL AGENT FOR THE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS GRANT PROGRAM AS ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE U.S. ATTORNEY FOR THE NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA AND THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, IN OAKLAND **SUPPORT OF** THE POLICE **DEPARTMENT'S CRIMINALISTICS DIVISION**

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) will be received from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services, Project Safe Neighborhoods grant program, in support of the Police Department's Criminalistics Division's Firearms Unit; and

WHEREAS, the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address gun violence through the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, the PSN grant funds shall assist in improving the Firearms Unit's ability to examine and document evidence through the acquisition of specialized equipment and workstation enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 79644 C.M.S., dated December 20, 2005; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate a grant in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services, to be allocated to the State of California, Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund (2999): Criminalistics Division Org. (102610); Criminalistics Division Program (PS05), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.
