SUMMARY

Recently, parcels within the boundaries of the City of Oakland Fire Area Utility Underground Reassessment District 99-1, an Improvement Bond Act of 1915 Assessment Districts, namely reassessment numbers 13, 889, 890, 891, 1882G and 1882H have subdivided. Similarly, parcels within City of Oakland Skyline Sewer Assessment District have subdivided also, namely assessment numbers 1G and 1H.

Whenever a property in this type of district (a 1915 Act Assessment District) subdivides, the assessment lien needs to be apportioned to each of the newly created parcels. This "apportionment process" generally consists of filing an Amended Assessment Diagram, a Notice of Amended Assessment, and apportioning the original lien amounts to the newly created parcels based upon the benefit received. When an apportionment is completed, the Amended Assessment Diagram and the Notice of Amended Assessment is recorded with the County Recorder, creating new liens.

NBS, an assessment-engineering firm, who manages the City of Oakland assessment districts, sent out letters on December 27, 2008, on behalf of the Districts notifying the affected property owners that the apportionment process needed to be complete by January 17, 2009 for the subdivided parcels. The property owners failed to respond by the due date specified. Therefore, staff is requesting that City Council approve the six resolutions allowing the City to move forward, with NBS assistance, on the apportionment process.

FISCAL IMPACT

No fiscal impact to the General Fund, however it is critical to record apportionment in a timely and accurate manner to ensure that all parcels within the assessment districts are properly assessed, thus allowing the City of Oakland to service its debt to bondholders without a risk of under-collecting. Total collections for Fire Area Assessment District is \$19,454.86 and for the Skyline Assessment District is \$13,999.56.

BACKGROUND

Fire Area Utility Underground Assessment District

The City of Oakland formed the Fire Area Utility Underground Assessment District No. 1994-1 (the "Assessment District") pursuant to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, Division 12 of the California Streets and Highway Code in December 1994 and issued Limited Obligation Improvement Bonds Fire Area Utility Underground Assessment District No. 1994-1, Series 1994A and Series 1994B (collectively, the "1994-1 Bonds"). The 1994-1 Bonds were issued to finance the costs of acquisition and installation of underground electric, telephone, and cable television public utility lines, a street lighting system and related street improvement.

In July 1999, through the Oakland Joint Powers Financing Authority (the "JPFA"), the City issued the Reassessment Revenue Bonds, Series 1999 (the "1999 Bonds") to refund and defease the 1994-1 Bonds and the Rockridge Area Water Improvement, Series 1994. Under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913, the Refunding Act of 1984 for the 1915 Improvement Act Bonds, Resolution of Intention No. 69877 C.M.S. and Resolution No.75100 C.M.S., special reassessments were confirmed to pay the costs of the acquisitions and improvement within the Assessment District.

Skyline Sewer Assessment District

The City issued the Limited Obligation Improvement Bonds, Skyline Sewer Assessment District pursuant to the Improvement Bond Act of 1915 Division 10 of the Streets and Highway Code and Resolution No. 71096 C.M.S. adopted by City Council on June 14, 1994 for the acquisition and/or construction of public improvements. The Skyline Sewer Bonds were later refunded by the JPFA, Special Assessment Pooled Revenue Bonds, 1996 Series A. Under the Municipal

Improvement Act of 1915 and Resolution No.71096 C.M.S., special reassessments were confirmed to pay the costs of acquisitions and improvements within the Skyline Sewer Assessment District.

Both the Fire Area Utility Underground Assessment District No. 1994-1 and Skyline Sewer Assessment District (collectively, the "Districts") collect reassessment fees to pay for the Reassessment Revenue Bonds Series 1999 and Skyline Sewer Assessment Bonds annual debt service payments and other related costs associated with administering these bonds. A reassessment fee is a charge levied by the Districts against a parcel of land within a District's service boundary for the benefit of having a public improvement project.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Parts 10 and 10.5 of Division 10 of the California Streets and Highways Code require an apportionment of an assessment lien every time a subdivision, lot line adjustment, or other reconfiguration of land occurs to a property within a 1915 Act Assessment District. Therefore, apportionments are required by law and must be performed.

NBS records show that parcels listed in the attached Reassessment Apportionment Reports (Attachments A-D) have not undergone the apportionment process in accordance with the 1915 Act. On December 27, 2008 a letter was sent out by NBS on the District's behalf to notify the affected property owners that the apportionment process needed to be completed by January 17, 2009 for the subdivided parcels.

The affected property owners failed to respond by the due date of January 17, 2009. Therefore, the Districts needs to proceed with a public hearing to authorize NBS to perform the apportionment and to place an additional levy on these properties to pay for NBS fees for doing the apportionment and other administrative related costs. The additional levy will appear on the FY09-10 tax roll for these specific parcels.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, that:

- 1. All written and oral protests are hereby overruled, and this Council has thereby acquired jurisdiction to order said Amended Assessments and re-confirms said Amended Assessment Diagram and Amended Assessment Roll, referenced herein, and the costs and expenses thereof.
- 2. Said Amended Assessment Diagram and said Amended Assessment Roll, referenced herein, filed with the City Clerk pursuant to "Resolution Ordering the Making of Amended Assessments Pursuant to Part 10 of Division 10 of the Streets and Highways Code and Directing Actions with Respect Thereto" is hereby, ratified, approved, and re-confirmed.
- 3. The City Clerk of the City of Oakland shall forthwith:
 - a) cause an Amended Notice of Assessment, amending the Notice of Assessment which was previously recorded on the 24th day of June 1994 in Book 9, Page 35, Document No. 94234810 for the Assessment Numbers 1G and 1H, executed by the City Clerk of the City of Oakland, to be filed and recorded, in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Alameda and such Amended Notice of Assessment to be in substantially the same form as provided in Section 3114 of the Streets and Highways Code of California;
 - b) cause an Amended Assessment Diagram, amending the Assessment Diagram which was previously recorded on the 24th day of June 1994 in Book 9, Page 35, Document No. 94234810 for the Assessment Numbers 1G and 1H, executed by the City Clerk of the City of Oakland, to be filed and recorded, in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Alameda and such Amended Assessment Diagram to be in substantially the same form as provided in Section 3114 of the Streets and Highways Code of California;

c) deliver the Amended Assessment Roll to the Superintendent of Streets, together with the Amended Assessment Diagram, as approved and re-confirmed by this Council, with a certificate of such confirmation and the date thereof, executed by the City Clerk of the City of Oakland thereon. The Superintendent of Streets will record the Amended Assessment Diagram and Amended Assessment Roll in his office in a suitable book to be kept for that purpose, and appended thereto his certificate of the date of such recording, and such recordation shall be and constitute the Amended Assessment Roll herein.
