FURTHER RESOLVED: That pursuant to OMC Section 9.64.040.2, based upon the information provided in City staff's Annual Surveillance Report and after considering the recommendation of the Privacy Advisory Commission referenced above and discussed in the Agenda Report accompanying this resolution, the City Council hereby finds that the benefits to the community of the surveillance technology outweigh the costs (cost-benefit determination); that the proposal will safeguard civil liberties and civil rights, and that no alternative with a lesser economic cost or impact on civil rights or civil liberties would be as effective; and so upholds the authorization of the City Administrator to continue use of the Apricot 360 platform.
