RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$200,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, SERVING AS THE FISCAL AGENT FOR PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS AS ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE U.S. ATTORNEY, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, IN SUPPORT OF THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIMINALISTICS DIVISION AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS GROUP

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) will be received from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services, in support of the Oakland Police Department Criminalistics Division and Special Operations Group; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that up to \$95,000 of said funds shall be designated for the Criminalistics Division, Firearms Unit, and up to \$105,000 shall be designated for the Special Operations Group, Gun Violence Reduction Plan; and

WHEREAS, these State of California, Project Safe Neighborhoods grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address gun violence through comprehensive programs in the City of Oakland; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept up to \$200,000 in grant funds from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services and appropriate said funds to the Police Department; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the funds for the Oakland Police Department, Criminalistics Laboratory, Firearms Unit shall be maintained in the State of California, Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund: 2999; Criminalistics Division Org.: 102610; Criminalistics Division Program: PS05, in a Project Number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the funds for the Oakland Police Department, Special Operations Group, Gun Violence Reduction Program shall be maintained in the State of California, Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund: 2999; Special Operations Division Org.: 101140; Special Operations Division Program: PS12, in a Project Number to be established; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.


