

Resolution No. 86252 C.M.S.

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### RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-17 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION

**WHEREAS**, Article XIII B of the California Constitution (Limitation of Government Appropriations) was passed by the California electorate on November 6, 1979, and became effective on July 1, 1980; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chapter 1205, Statute of 1980, Section 7900 of the Government Code, formally implements methods for governmental entities to establish and define annual appropriations limits, based on annual appropriations for the prior fiscal year, which is fiscal year 2015-16, for fiscal year 2016-17; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**: That the annual appropriations limit for the City of Oakland for FY 2016-17 is \$580,455,234 as reflected in Exhibit A; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the growth factors used to calculate the limit are the county population change and the increase in the California per capita income.


