

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO AWARD AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES FOR THE ESTUARY PARK RENOVATION AND EXPANSION PROJECT (#1000858) WITH HARGREAVES ASSOCIATES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,200,000.00)**

**WHEREAS**, on November 5, 2002 Oakland voters passed Measure DD, the Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks, a \$198,250,000 general obligation bond authorizing the City to sell bonds to raise funds for a variety of park and water projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Measure DD, Series 2017C bonds in the amount of up to \$27,500,000 were issued and appropriated in FY 2017/17, per Resolution No. 86516 C.M.S.; and

**WHEREAS**, Estuary Park is a project identified under Measure DD category for Estuary Waterfront Access, Parks and Cleanup Program and funds are available in Measure DD, Series C, Fund (5322); Capital Projects Organization (92270); Consultant Contract Account (54411); Project (1000858); Program (IN06).

**WHEREAS**, a Professional Services Request for Proposals was advertised on October 14, 2016, in accordance with Administrative Instruction 150 and six (6) responses were received by Public Works Contract Services on November 29, 2016; and

**WHEREAS**, City Administrator's Contract Compliance analysis was completed on December 5, 2016 to the Request for Proposals and revised on June 9, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the professional architectural design services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Section 2.04.051 A; and

**WHEREAS**, the top four firms were invited to participate in a panel interview on March 1, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds and determines based on the representations set forth in the City Administrator's report accompanying this Resolution that the professional services contract approved hereunder is temporary in nature; and
