AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.10, TITLE 5 OF THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE, TO DELETE THE \$250.00 MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF A DOOR PRIZE, AND TO DELETE THE TWO-DAY LIMIT IN A CALENDAR WEEK THAT AN ORGANIZATION CAN CONDUCT BINGO GAMES

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the following sections of Chapter 5.10 of title 5 of the Oakland Municipal Code are amended to read as set forth below:

SECTION 5.10.170 Maximum Amount of Prize

The total value of prizes awarded during the conduct of any bingo game shall not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) in cash or kind, both for each separate game which is held.

~~The total value of a door prize shall not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) in cash or kind.~~

SECTION 5.10.300 Number of games-Notice to police department

~~No permittee shall conduct bingo games pursuant to any permit more often than twice in any calendar week.~~ At least five days before any bingo game is to be conducted, the permittee shall notify the Vice Control division of the Oakland Police Department of the time and place of said game.

SECTION 2. With the exception of the above-amended sections, all other provisions of Chapter 5.10 of Title 5 of the Oakland Municipal Code shall remain in effect as enacted. Provisions enacted under this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by the City Council.
