

WHEREAS, the subject no-parking anytime zone has been successfully petitioned by adjacent residents; now, therefore, be it
<b>RESOLVED:</b> That the establishment of a no-parking anytime zone on the south side of San Antonio Way between 17 <sup>th</sup> Avenue and 18 <sup>th</sup> Avenue is hereby approved.
