RE: FY 09-11 Public Safety Proposals - Parking Control Officers & Police Services Add-Backs

As Chairperson of the Public Safety Committee, I am presenting two proposals for discussion that will potentially impact the FY 09-11 City of Oakland Budget. The following is a summary of the two proposals:

Parking Control Officers

Currently, the Oakland Police Department is responsible for traffic control activities for special events as defined by §12.44.180, Paragraph A of the Oakland Municipal Code (See Attachment A). As a result of rising costs and other economic challenges facing the City, several historically-held community and business, social and cultural events were cancelled this fiscal year.

In order to maximize the current resources, I am proposing to reclassify the Parking Control technicians to Parking Control Officers. The attached proposal (See Attachment B) contains information comparing the job duties, base salary, and cost savings related to police officers, parking control technicians, and parking control officers within the Oakland San Francisco areas.

Police Service Add-Backs

After reviewing the FY 09-11 Mayor's Budget and the City Council's proposal dated June 16, 2009, I am recommending restoring the Helicopter costs of \$378,000 and the Take-Home Vehicles costs of \$80,000 for senior-level and critical emergency staff only by reallocating or reducing the funding in the police overtime line item to support these activities. I've attached Exhibit B from previous budget reports and highlighted portions of OPD's budget where funds are allocated for overtime.

It is my hope that during our budget discussions that these proposals will be taken into consideration.

12.44.150 Appeal procedure.

- A. The applicant shall have the right to appeal one or more permit conditions or the denial of a permit. The applicant shall also have the right to appeal the amount of fees, or cleanup deposits imposed pursuant to Section 12.44.190.
- B. A notice of appeal stating the grounds for the appeal shall be filed with the City Clerk within five days after mailing or personal delivery of a notice of denial or notice of permit condition(s).
- C. If an applicant files an appeal, the City Manager or his or her designee shall hold a hearing no later than two business days after the filing of the appeal, and will render a decision no later than one business day after hearing the appeal. The City Manager's decision is final. (Prior code § 3-6.08 (§ 14))

12.44.160 Permit issuance.

The Chief of Police shall issue the parade permit once:

- A. Final action has been taken on the application pursuant to Sections 12.44.120A or 12.44.150C; and
- B. Where conditions have been imposed, the applicant has agreed in writing to comply with the terms and conditions of the permit; and
- C. The following sections of this article have been complied with:
- 1. Section 12.44.170 pertaining to indemnification;
- 2. Section 12.44.180 pertaining to police traffic control costs;
- 3. Section 12.44.190 pertaining to cleanup deposits (when applicable). (Prior code § 3-6.08 (§ 15))

12.44.170 Indemnification agreement.

A. Prior to the issuance of a parade permit, the permit applicant and president or designee of the sponsoring organization(s) (if any), must sign an agreement to reimburse the city for any costs insofar as permitted by law, arising from the repair of damage to city property proximately caused at the parade by the actions of the permittee, sponsoring organization, its officers, employees, or agents, or

any person who was under the permittee's or sponsoring organization's control.

- B. The agreement shall also provide that the permittee and/or sponsoring organization shall defend the city against, and indemnify and hold the city harmless from, any liability to any persons resulting from any damage or injury occurring in connection with the permitted parade proximately caused by the actions of the permittee and/or sponsoring organization, its officers, employees or agents, or any person who was under the permittee's and/or sponsoring organization's control.
- C. Persons who merely join in a parade are not considered by that reason alone to be "under the control" of the permittee or sponsoring organization. (Prior code § 3-6.08 (§ 16))

12.44.180 Traffic control fees—Use of pre-established event routes.

- A. Prepayment of Fees. Upon approval of an application for a parade permit, the Chief of Police shall provide the applicant with a statement of the estimated cost of providing police officers for traffic control at the parade. The applicant/sponsor shall be required to prepay the traffic control fees prior to the issuance of a parade permit. Traffic control includes clearing the parade route or site of unauthorized vehicles, diversion of traffic around the parade, and directing pedestrian and vehicular traffic along the route of the parade.
- B. Computing Traffic Control Costs. The traffic control costs shall be computed by determining the number of police officers who will be required for traffic control beyond that which would otherwise be required at that time multiplied by the number of hours for which such additional service is rendered at the rate of the city's full cost of providing officers on an hourly basis as established by the Police Department's fee schedule.
- . C. Refunds or Additional Charges. If the actual cost for traffic control on the date of the parade is less than the estimated cost pursuant to subsection A of this section, the applicant/sponsor will be promptly refunded the difference by the city. If more police hours are required than originally

Definition

Under general supervision, patrols an assigned area for the purpose of enforcing motor vehicle parking regulations, and performs related duties as required. Essential functions include: Operating a three-wheel vehicle, or walking, or riding a bicyc or driving a van or automobile in patrolling the streets; issuing citations for illegal parking by means of handwritten and/or computer generated citations; directing vehicular and pedestrian traffic through the use of appropriate hand signals and whist at specific intersections or control points; operating a radio transmitter to keep in contact with supervisors and to report circumstances requiring police action; preparing reports; and interacting with the public in explaining policies and procedures.

Distinguishing Features

₩Positions in this class are staffed by civilian employees who normally wear a uniform and badge but do not carry weapons and are responsible for explaining and enforcing provisions of the California Vehicle Code and local traffic codes related to the movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic and parking regulations. Positions in this class are further distinguished by the need for making regular, responsible public contact concerning traffic direction and control. Employees will be required to work any shift, rotating shifts, weekends, and holidays and may be required to work overtime.

Supervision Exercised

None.

Examples of Important and Essential Duties

According to Civil Service Commission rule 9, the duties specified below are representative of the range of duties assigned to class 8214 Parking Control Officer and are not intended to be an inclusive list.

- 1. Patrolling the streets in an assigned area to cite illegally parked vehicles and to enforce motor vehicle parking regulations. Places identifying marks on parked vehicles, or records identifying information into hand-held computer, and subsequently checks for these data/marks as means of identifying vehicles which are parked beyond the legal time limit.
- 2. Arranges for removal of unlawfully parked vehicles as authorized by various state and local codes; completes inventory for describing contents of the vehicle and any visible damage or missing parts.
- 3. Directs vehicular and pedestrian traffic by using appropriate hand signals and whistles at a specific intersection or other control points; assists pedestrians in crossing from curb to curb at intersections; directs traffic and manages crowds at the perimeters of fires, accidents, parades, and other public functions.
- 4. Operates and monitors a radio transmitter to keep in contact with supervisors and to inform departmental supervisors and dispatch centers of any circumstances requiring police or emergency assistance and acts in accordance with instructions

- 5. Makes notes of actions taken in line of duty and prepares detailed reports describing unusual problems encountered or instances observed relating to parking and traffic control; prepares daily reports.
- 6. Explains parking and traffic regulations; provides information in response to questions about routes of travel, points of interest, distances and related matters to the public; advises the public as to how and where they may contact the Police Department.
- 7. Lifts and attaches vehicle immobilization unit in order to immobilize vehicles.
- 8. Operates a motor vehicle with standard or automatic transmission, vans, and 3-wheel vehicles.
- 9. Performs related duties and responsibilities as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Knowledge of: California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic, Harbor and Park Codes; San Francisco street names, locations of public buildings, and recreational facilities, routes of travel, and other points of interest.

Ability to: Communicate clearly and effectively orally and in writing; accurately analyze situations and take an effective course action; effectively interact with the public, parking violators, supervisors and staff in a tactful and courteous manner; read and understand departmental policies, rules, instructions, various codes, and city street maps; observe and recall street details ar incidents; work independently with minimal supervision and under stressful and hostile conditions

Experience and Training

Experience: Two years of satisfactory public contact experience which must include providing information, or applying and explaining rules, regulations, and procedures, or responding to complaints as a primary responsibility; or two years military service on either active or reserve duty; or six months of experience as a parking control officer.

Training: High school diploma or equivalent (GED or High School Proficiency Examination). Sixty semester units or ninety quarter units from an accredited college or university may substitute for experience.

License or Certificate

Current valid Driver's License.

Special Requirements: Essential duties require the following physical skills and work environment: sit, stand, and walk for extended periods; engage in the repetitive motions involved in generating citations with a hand held computer or by hand and directing traffic; work in inclement weather Some positions require the ability to lift 40 pounds as required to lift and attach a weblic immobilization unit or to lift and position police barricades. Duties sometime involve interacting with the public under thostile conditions.
