RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, WITHOUT RETURNING TO CITY COUNCIL, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE LICENSE (METHYENZENTES SWITCH THE OAKLAND HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR FREE USE OF PROGRAM SPACE AT 935 UNION STREET AND 800 WILLOW STREET (CAMPBELL VILLAGE) IN WEST

UNION STREET AND 800 WILLOW STREET (CAMPBELL VILLAGE) IN WEST OAKLAND FOR A PERIOD OF FIFTEEN MONTHS AND THIRTEEN MONTHS RESPECTIVELY WITH AN OPTION TO RENEW ANNUALLY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) and the Oakland Housing Authority (OHA) are working together in order to provide high-quality free programs to low-income children and youth in West Oakland; and

WHEREAS, OHA requires that the City enter into a license agreement for each site to be used that specifies the terms under which OPR may use each site; and

WHEREAS, this partnership serves to leverage resources while expanding service delivery to underserved and low income Oakland residents; and

WHEREAS, West Oakland has been identified as an area in which children and youth are significantly underserved for after school and summer programs; and

WHEREAS, OPR and OHA can collaborate in order to offer the young people in West Oakland constructive, positive options when school is not in session and the need is greatest; and

WHEREAS, the sites, located at 935 Union Street and 800 Willow Street, respectively, are adequate to house OPR's proposed programs; and

WHEREAS, this project has the potential to improve public safety by providing a safe place for OHA residents and other low-income children and youth to engage in constructive educational and youth development activities; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** that the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute license agreements with the Oakland Housing Authority for free use of program space at 800 Willow Street (Campbell Village) and 935 Union Street in West Oakland; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the Office of the City Attorney has approved this resolution as to form and legality, and a copy will be on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
