RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE HAZARD ELIMINATION SAFETY (HES) PROGRAM STATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$90,000) FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT THE INTERSECTION OF SAN LEANDRO STREET AT 66TH AVENUE

WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is responsible for disbursing federal funds from the Hazard Elimination Safety (HES) Program for safety improvements that eliminate or reduce the number and severity of traffic accidents; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor/Council goals include improving traffic safety including pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland applied for and was awarded HES funds in the amount of \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide a local match in the amount of \$10,000 from Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds (Resolution No. 77748, approved on April 15, 2003); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the City Administrator, or her designee, to accept and appropriate the Hazard Elimination Safety funds in the amount of \$90,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests, and related actions, as well as to appropriate any additional grant funds received for the completion of this project.
