





Since September 2000:

- Ninety-three (93%) of all claims and lawsuits filed against the Police Department were resolved for less than \$5,000.
- Eighty percent (80%) of these matters were closed with zero payout.
- Of the 581 use-of-force claims and lawsuits,
 92% were resolved for zero payout.
