CONSTRUCTION, INC., FOR THE REHABILITATION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN MARKET ST., 45<sup>TH</sup> ST., AND WEST ST. (PART OF SUBBASIN 50-03) (PROJECT NO. C65120) FOR THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE

**DOLLARS (\$1,250,225)** 

#### **SUMMARY**

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Manager to award a construction contract in the amount of \$1,250,225 to Andes Construction, Inc., (Oakland) for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in Market St., 45" St., and West St. (*Part* of Subbasin 50-03) (Project No. C65120).

#### **FISCAL IMPACTS**

There are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. Funding for this project is available in the Sewer Service Fund (3100); Organization (92244); Account (57417); Project (C65120). The engineer's estimate for the work is \$1,322,250.

#### **BACKGROUND**

On August 11,2003, the City Clerk received two bids for this project in the amounts of \$1,250,225 and \$1,589,050 as shown in the table below. The lowest responsible bidder, Andes Construction, Inc., (Oakland), with a bid amount of \$1,250,225, is recommended for award. Staff has reviewed the bid and believes that the unit costs are reasonable for the work anticipated.

This project meets the Mayor/City Council and Citywide Objectives to Maintain and Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets.

Under the proposed contract with Andes Construction, Inc., the SLBE participation is \$1,075,225 (86%). The percentage exceeds the City's 50% SLBE. Also, the contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

#### **KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS**

Construction under this contract is scheduled to begin in October 2003 and be completed by June 2004. The contract specifies \$1,000 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time of 90 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment A*.

Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and determined that the low bid is reasonable.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

**Economic:** The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents.

**Environmental:** The replacement of the sanitary sewers will eliminate the possibility of sewer leakage and overflows and thus prevent potential harm to groundwater resources and the bay. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

**Social Equity:** This project is part of the citywide program to eliminate wastewater overflows thereby benefiting all Oakland residents.

#### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact or benefit to seniors or people with disabilities.

#### RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to Andes Construction, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,250,225 for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in Market St., 45<sup>th</sup> St., and West St. (Part of Subbasin 50-03) (Project No. C65120). Andes Construction, Inc., has met the local business requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.
