RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS TO THE SAN ANTONIO COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FOR A TOTAL NOT TO EXCEED \$31,555 TO PROVIDE SMALL BUSINESS AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE TO 23RD AVENUE MERCHANTS, SAN ANTONIO MERCHANTS, AND PROPERTY OWNERS ALONG THE 23RD AVENUE CORRIDOR

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland's Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) is engaged in a Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization (NCR) Program throughout Oakland which coordinates physical improvement and business assistance; and

WHEREAS, the 23^{rd} Avenue corridor is a designated Neighborhood Commercial Revitalization target area; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Community Development Corporation has been actively coordinating projects for the last six years along the 23rd Avenue Comdor and has worked closely with other City agencies on the completion of several neighborhood improvement initiatives along the comdor; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Community Development Corporation has the experience in project coordination and community revitalization and is uniquely qualified to provide small business assistance; and

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Community Development District has recommended the allocation of \$31,555 from the 1999-2000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Community Development District's Reprogramming Funds to the San Antonio Community Development Corporation to provide small business assistance services to merchants and property owners; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby allocates, from Fund No. 2108, Organizational No. 88821, Account No. 78811, and Project No. G10090, CDBG funds to the San Antonio Community Development Corporation, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$31,555 to promote small business assistance to 23rd Avenue merchants, San Antonio merchants, and property owners; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute a funding agreement with the San Antonio Community Development Corporation, Inc., for this allocation, and to take any other action as necessary with respect to these activities consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve all such documents as to form and legality prior to execution.
