85TH ANNIVERSARY RESOLUTION CELEBRATING THE OF OAKLAND'S FEATHER RIVER CAMP

WHEREAS, Mr. J.B. Nash, Superintendent of the Oakland Recreation Department from 1917-1926, leased land in 1921 from the National Forest Service and thus launched Oakland's camping program; and

WHEREAS, the Feather River Camp was founded in 1924; and

WHEREAS, the Mountain Camp programs for boys and girls were transferred to the Feather River site in 1968, and the Feather River Camp has included many programs for children and youth since this time; and

WHEREAS, the first deaf children's Mountain Camp week was held in 1973 at Feather River in cooperation with EBCARD, and the first Office of Parks and Recreation Senior Citizens week began at Feather River Camp; and

WHEREAS, theme camping was first introduced at Feather River Camp in 1986 with specialty youth camps in Basketball, Computers and Dance; and

WHEREAS, a new Master Plan was developed in 1988 to strengthen total camp operations and renovation was completed on primary electrical services to principal buildings and approximately 50% of the cabins and tents; and

WHEREAS, disabled campers utilized the camp's accessible facilities for the first time in 1993; and

WHEREAS, in 2002, budget cuts threatened camp closure and the Oakland Feather River Campers began meeting to devise ways to help the City save money and run a quality camp; and

WHEREAS, Camps in Common, a nonprofit organization, was formed in 2003 to assume operation of the Oakland Feather River Camp; and

WHEREAS, Measure WW was passed in 2008 and the City approved \$500K for infrastructure improvements to the Oakland Feather River Camp; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Feather River Camp is celebrating is 85th anniversary; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: the City of Oakland joins Camps in Common in celebrating the 85th Anniversary of the Oakland Feather River Camp and encourages all Oaklanders to utilize the wonderful city resource of Feather River this summer and every summer.
