### Overview of TPA

TPA has secured over \$3 billion in public sector funding for our clients.





# **TPA/City Partnership**

TPA secured over **\$826 million** in state and federal grants for the City of Oakland's projects, including public safety, housing and development, transportation, parks and recreation, education, and cultural resources.

TPA has shepherded over **100 legislative** and regulatory proposals into law, including over **32 bills** that were sponsored by and specific to the City.
