WHEREAS, those groups eventually grew into today's Unity Council and the Spanish Speaking Citizens' Foundation; and

WHEREAS, Dominguita Velasco has been an active resident of Posada De Colores for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, Dominguita Velasco has contributed to the making and the history of Oakland's Latino community for the past nine decades now, therefore, be it
