RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH BERRYMAN AND HENIGAR FOR THE STREET SURVEY AND PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROGRAM UPDATE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$315,000.00

WHEREAS, the project consists of surveying the City of Oakland's street network according to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission's standardized inspections, updating the Pavement Management System with the inspection information, and linking the Pavement Management System to the Geographic Information System; and

WHEREAS, Berryman and Henigar has submitted a proposal to provide professional services to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, Berryman and Henigar was chosen through the City's Request for Proposal process as the top rated firm to provide the services; and

WHEREAS, Berryman and Henigar has met the Local and Small Local Business requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this contract is for services of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds, from Measure B and the Municipal Improvement Capital Fund, in Projects C235010, C235011, and C17180, for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Berryman and Henigar to provide professional services for the Street Survey and Pavement Management Program Update in an amount not to exceed \$315,000.00; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement except those involving compensation or the allocation of additional funds provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of the agreement will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
