RESOLUTION NO. 910691 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION: (1) AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ALLSTAR FIRE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIREFIGHTER PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (ALSO KNOWN AS TURNOUTS) FOR A THREE YEAR TERM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000), WITH AN OPTION TO EXTEND THE AGREEMENT FOR UP TO TWO YEARS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS PER YEAR (\$500,000), WITHOUT RETURNING TO COUNCIL, FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,500,000); AND (2) WAIVING THE ADVERTISING AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS REQUIREMENTS, AND LOCAL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE AND SMALL LOCAL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (LBE/SLBE) PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PROPOSED PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH ALLSTAR FIRE EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, Firefighter safety clothing is a mandated requirement by CAL-OSHA and the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Oakland and Local 55; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department (OFD or Department) is required to provide ongoing replacement of damaged or sub-standard turnout clothing worn by sworn personnel responding to emergency situations, and protective clothing for firefighter recruits in the training academies; and

WHEREAS, to ensure that firefighting personnel have the most effective, technologically sound safety gear, the OFD Safety Clothing Committee evaluated available safety clothing products from various manufacturers over a 12-month period; and

WHEREAS, upon conclusion of the evaluation period, it was determined that the turnouts manufactured by Janesville Lion Apparel (which are distributed by Allstar Fire Equipment) continue to best meet the operational and safety needs of the Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland (City) has a current contract with AllStar Fire Equipment in the amount of \$250,000 through August 4, 2026; and

WHEREAS, All Star Fire Equipment is located in Hayward, California and is the only vendor in Northern California authorized to distribute Lion Apparel safety clothing; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code section 2.04.050.I.5 permits the City Council to waive the advertising and bidding requirements upon a finding that it is in the best interest of the City to do so; and

WHEREAS, the City Council may waive the Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) Program requirements, last amended by Ordinance No. 13825 CMS (January 6, 2025); and

WHEREAS, for the considerations specified above and information specified in the Agenda Report accompanying this legislation, City staff recommends that City Council waive the advertising and bidding process (LBE/SLBE) Program requirements; now, therefore, be it

WHEREAS, funds for this contract for FY 2026 shall be drawn from available Oakland Fire Department budgeted funds, including GPF 1010 Fire Academy Training Project 1004398 and funding for the future years of the contract is contingent upon appropriation in future budget cycles; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a three-year purchase agreement with All Star Fire Equipment in an amount not to exceed \$1,500,000 for the purchase of Firefighter Protective Clothing (Turnouts); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is also authorized to extend the agreement with All Star Fire Equipment an additional two years for five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000 per year, for a total amount not to exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the possible five-year term; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Section 2.04.050.1.5, and based on the reasons stated above and in the Agenda Report accompanying this legislation, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the best interests of the City to waive the advertising and bidding process, and the local and small business (LBE/SLBE) enterprise program provisions, and so waives such requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend this agreement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreement to form and legality and copies of said agreement shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
