**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR CITY OF OAKLAND PERSONNEL TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES AT THE OAKLAND AIRPORT FOR RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH NATURAL, HUMAN RELATED, AND OR TECHNOLOGICAL HAZARDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) has requested a memorandum of agreement be incorporated into the Air Traffic Control Tower Occupant Emergency Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland currently provides emergency services to the Port of Oakland; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 504(l) of the Oakland City Charter requires the City Council to authorize the City Administrator to enter into agreements with other government agencies; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** that the City Council authorizes the City Administrator enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Federal Aviation Administration to provide emergency response services at the Oakland Airport, and specifically the Air Traffic Control Tower, for risks associated with natural, human related, and technological hazards; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that entering into this MOA will have no fiscal impact on the General Fund; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** that the City Attorney shall review and approve said agreement as to form and legality and copies of said agreement shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
