During college I was on the College Board at Capwell's in Oakland. In 1961 I graduated from U.C. Berkeley with a degree in History and Interior Design. I also attended the Sorbonne in Paris, La Escuela des Artes Plasticas in Guadalajara, Mexico, and San Francisco State University.

I taught social studies at Mission High School and later social studies and art at Lowell High School, both in San Francisco.

I was a docent at the S.F. Museum of Art when it was located on Van Ness Avenue, a sustaining docent at the Audubon Canyon Ranch, and co-chairman of the first Marin Landscape Garden Show.
