RE: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO ANDES

CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE REHABILITATION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN THE AREA BOUNDED BY MACARTHUR BOULEVARD, PATTERSON AVENUE, REINHARDT DRIVE, CARSON STREET AND MADRONE STREET-SUB-BASIN 81-014 (PROJECT NO. C157910) FOR THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND SEVENTY-NINE

DOLLARS (\$1,415,079)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to award a construction contract in the amount of \$1,415,079 to Andes Construction, Inc. for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by MacArthur Boulevard, Patterson Avenue, Reinhardt Drive, Carson Street and Madrone Street – Sub-basin 81-014 (Project No. C157910). The work to be completed under this project is part of the City's annual sanitary sewer rehabilitation program. The work is located in Council District 4.

FISCAL IMPACT

There are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work. Funding for this project is available in the Sewer Service Fund (3100); Capital Projects-Sanitary Sewer Design Organization (92244); Sewers Account (57417); Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by MacArthur Boulevard, Patterson Avenue, Reinhardt Drive, Carson Street and Madrone Street-Sub-basin 81-014 Project (C157910). These funds were specifically allocated for this project. The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$1,787,445.

BACKGROUND

On December 13, 2004 the City Clerk received two bids for this project in the amounts of \$1,415,079 and \$1,726,738 as shown in *Attachment A*. Andes Construction, Inc. received a 5% discount as a certified SLBE bidding as a prime for a discounted bid price of \$1,344,325.05 for bid comparison purposes. Therefore, Andes Construction, with the bid price of \$1,415,079, is recommended for award.

This project will rehabilitate and upgrade the sanitary sewers within the project area, eliminate the infiltration of rain and groundwater into the sanitary sewer system, and limit the overflows

and backups during wet weather. This project meets the Mayor/Council Goals and Citywide Objective to maintain and enhance Oakland's physical assets by providing for well-maintained sanitary sewer systems. The project continues Oakland's compliance under its sewer permit with the Regional Water Quality Control Board.

In general, the proposed work consists of rehabilitating/replacing approximately 13,800 linear feet of existing 8" and 10" diameter sewer pipes; rehabilitating sewers structures; reconnecting house connection sewers; rehabilitating house connection sewers; and other ancillary work as indicated on the plans and specifications.

Under the proposed contract with Andes Construction, Inc., SLBE participation of \$1,400,079 (98.94%) exceeds the City's 20% LBE/SLBE requirement. The contractor shows \$10,000 (100%) for trucking that exceeds the 20% Local Trucking participation requirement. The contractor received 5% credit for LBE/SLBE preference or \$70,752.95, that made the adjusted bid amount \$1,344,325.05. The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office and is shown in *Attachment B*.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction is scheduled to begin in early June 2005 and should be completed by December 2005. The contract specifies \$1,000 in liquidated damages per working day if the contract completion time of 120 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment A*.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES


Economic: The contractor is required to have 50% of the work hours performed by Oakland residents, and 50% of all new hires are to be Oakland residents.

<u>Environmental</u>: The replacement of the sanitary sewers will eliminate the possibility of sewer leakage and overflows and thus prevent potential harm to groundwater resources and the bay. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

<u>Social Equity:</u> This project is part of the citywide program to eliminate wastewater overflows, thereby benefiting all Oakland residents.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

There is no direct impact or benefit to seniors or people with disabilities.



RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to Andes Construction, Inc. the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,415,079 for the Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers in the Area Bounded by Macarthur Boulevard, Patterson Avenue, Reinhardt Drive, Carson Street and Madrone Street – Sub-basin 81-014 (Project No. C157910). Andes Construction has met the LBE/SLBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.
