RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE WEEK OF MAY 12, 2006 - MAY 21, 2006, AFFORDABLE HOUSING WEEK IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, decent, safe and affordable housing is one of the basic necessities of life and is of vital importance to the health and well being of all residents of the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, thousands of residents in Alameda County live in overcrowded, substandard and otherwise inadequate housing; and

WHEREAS, thousands more are paying over 30% of their income for housing and are at significant risk of losing their housing and becoming homeless; and

WHEREAS, thousands of units of affordable housing have been built by non-profit developers and others in Alameda County; and

WHEREAS, these affordable housing units are well managed, well maintained and have contributed significantly to neighborhoods throughout the City of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, East Bay Housing Organizations have organized events during Affordable Housing Week to acknowledge the need for and contributions of affordable housing; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED: that members of the Oakland City Council proclaim the week of May 12 to May 21, 2006 as Affordable Housing Week in the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oakland City Council calls upon all residents of the City of Oakland to learn about and honor the contributions of affordable housing by participating in activities held throughout the week to commemorate this observance.


