INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER RAMACHANDRAN

ADOPT A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE DIWALI, THE FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS CELEBRATED BY SOUTH ASIAN COMMUNITIES WORLDWIDE, AND IN THE SPIRIT OF DIWALI 2023 HONOR MOTHERLAND NEPAL FOR THEIR POWERFUL WORK TO UPFLIFT OAKLAND'S NEPALI IMMIGRANT COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, Diwali, a festival of great significance to South Asians and the South Asian Diaspora across the world, is celebrated annually by nearly two billion people of different religions, including Hindus, Sikhs, and Buddhists; and

WHEREAS, Diwali, one of the world's oldest holidays, brings together family, friends, and communities across Oakland to celebrate the triumph of light over darkness and good over evil; and

WHEREAS, Diwali, derived from the Sanskrit word Deepavali, means "rows of lights", Diwali is often celebrated by burning clay lamps around the home, distribution of sweets and gifts to neighbors, community song and dance traditions and street festivals; and

WHEREAS, Diwali falls on Sunday, November 12th this year; and

WHEREAS, Oakland is home to a large South Asian community, including Nepali, Bhutanese, Indian, Sri Lankan and Pakistani Diaspora communities; and

WHEREAS, this Diwali 2023, the City of Oakland wants to specifically uplift the contributions of thousands of Oakland Nepali residents and hundreds of small businesses for their cultural and economic contributions to Oakland;

WHEREAS, this Diwali 2023, Motherland Nepal is a key organization that provides a strong sense of community for Nepali immigrants across the Oakland and East Bay Nepali community through public advocacy, celebration of Nepali cultural traditions, social support and technical assistance;

now, therefore, be it **RESOLVED:** That the Oakland City Council recognizes the significance, both historical and cultural, of Diwali to the South Asian community in Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council recognizes Diwali on Sunday, November 12th and encourages the community to participate in celebrating this joyous holiday; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Oakland City Council recognizes Motherland Nepal as our honoree for Diwali 2023 and is grateful for the powerful community-building work they do for the Nepali diaspora community. We recognize the immense value of social and economic support they provide both for newly arrived immigrants as well as those who have called Oakland home for generations. We honor the immense contributions of this community to the economic fabric of the Town, through hundreds of small businesses in the hospitality, beauty, and restaurant businesses. Oakland City Council supports Motherland Nepal's efforts to continue to expand their support services to the Nepali immigrant community, including their quest to find a physical home for their cultural activities, to ensure all Nepalis have stable employment and safe housing, and to expand language access to monolingual Nepali speakers.
