RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE \$20,040 IN REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE TO THE COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY BUILDING SERVICES DIVISION

WHEREAS, on February 6, 2001, the City Council approved an Ordinance to adopt an eighteen month Pushcart Vending Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, implementation of the permanent Pushcart Food Vending Program would result in increased costs to the City for administration, enforcement and monitoring of the program, estimated at a cost of \$334 per vendor; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that 60 vendors would apply for permits under the Pushcart Vending Program, in FY 2003-2004; and

WHEREAS, the permit fees for 60 permits would generate \$20,040 annually in revenue, \$10,980 of which has already been factored into the FY 2003-2004 Adopted Policy Budget, leaving an estimated \$9,060 total revenue; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the public safety, health, convenience, comfort, and general welfare will be furthered by enforcement of the permanent Pushcart Food Vending Program; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized to appropriate \$20,040 in revenue and expenditure to the Community and Economic development Agency, Building Services Division, Pushcart/Vehicular Vending project account (P172620) for the sole purpose of administering and enforcing the program.
