THIS CASE INVOLVES CLAIMS OF VIOLATIONS OF CIVIL RIGHTS AGAINST AN OAKLAND POLICE OFFICER. (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – POLICE CONDUCT)

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Samuel Joseph Yopez v. City of Oakland, et al., Alameda County Superior Court Case No. 836215-7, City Attorney's File No. 20679, for a sum not to exceed a total of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00) payable by the City of Oakland to Samuel Joseph Yopez and Curtis G. Oler, Esq., his attorney of record;

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$35,000.00) be paid to Samuel Joseph Yopez and Curtis G. Oler, Esq., his attorney of record.


