

INTRODUCED BY PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE ABEL GUILLÉN

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO GRANT ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) TO API CULTURAL CENTER, INC. TO ASSIST IN THE COSTS OF MAINTAINENCE AND REPAIRS FOR THE OAKLAND ASIAN CULTURAL CENTER

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland (City) owns the condominium space at 388 9th Street, Suite 290, in the Pacific Renaissance Plaza; and

WHEREAS, the space was designed to house a cultural center facility referred to as the Oakland Asian Cultural Center (OACC); and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a management agreement with API Cultural Center, Inc. ("API") on February 27, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City budgeted \$100,000 to pay for needed maintenance and repairs to the heating ventilating and air conditioning ("HVAC") and other building systems at OACC; and

WHEREAS, the funds were allocated to Public Works to make the required repairs directly to the City facility; and

WHEREAS, the City now proposes to grant these funds to API and have API make the repairs to the City facility it is managing; and

WHEREAS, these funds need to be reallocated to the appropriate department to manage the grant - Economic and Workforce Development; and

WHEREAS, it is important to maintain public accessibility to OACC and the cultural vitality of the area; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to reallocate \$100,000 of funds to assist in the costs of maintenance and repairs for the Oakland Asian Cultural Center as designated in the following blocks:
