WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez was awarded NLPOA Officer of the Year in 2000; and awarded the community service award from the Oakland Police Department on August 31, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez joined the National Latino Peace Officers Association-Alameda County Chapter (NLPOA-Alameda County) in 1985 and served as its president form 1990 to 2000; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez, during his presidency of the NLPOA-Alameda County, established a program that served hot meals to the poor during the holiday season; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez established the NLPOA-Alameda County, Christmas Toy Give-Away, County Turkey give-away, Youth Soccer Team and Summer Camp program for children; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez raised and funded several scholarships for Oakland college bound youth; and

WHEREAS, Gabriel Cervantez was elected Executive Vice-President of the California State Board NLPOA from 1991-2001 and brought the State Convention to Oakland; and
