INTRODUCED BY THE CITY MANAGER

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH VOLUNTEERS OF AMERICA BAY AREA, INC., TO OPERATE THE OAKLAND DAY LABOR PROGRAM, FROM JULY 1, 2003 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2004, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$194,000

WHEREAS, the Oakland Day Labor Program administered by the Volunteers of America Bay Area, Inc., provides employment and social services to the Oakland casual laborer population and their families; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a series of professional services contracts and amendments with the Volunteers of America Bay Area, Inc., to operate the Oakland Day Labor Program, from July 19, 1999 through June 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to continue operation of this program, in accordance with stated public safety goals; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified \$200,000 of the General Fund, in Project A139610, for the continued operation of the Oakland Day Labor Program in its budget for Fiscal Year 2003-04, less the City's contract compliance fee of \$6,000, leaving an estimated \$194,000 available for this contract; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this contract is of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that this contract will not result in a loss of employment or salary by any person having a permanent status in the competitive service; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for professional services with Volunteers of America Bay Area, Inc., to operate the

Oakland Day Labor Program, from July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004, in an amount not to exceed \$194,000; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager and his or her designee are hereby authorized to take whatever action is necessary with respect to the Oakland Day Labor Program and the contract with Volunteers of America Bay Area, Inc., consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
