#### ORDINANCE AMENDING OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.04 TO EXEMPT ACQUISITION (ACCESSION) AND DISPOSITION (DEACCESSION) OF CITY OF OAKLAND PERSONAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS THE OAKLAND MUSEUM OF CALIFORNIA COLLECTIONS, FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE PURCHASING ORDINANCE, OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 2.04, APPLICABLE TO PURCHASE AND TO DISPOSITION AND DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

This ordinance will amend Oakland Municipal Code, Title II, Chapter 2.04, Purchasing System, to exempt the City's museum collections from the City's general requirements and procedures for the purchase, sale and disposal of supplies, goods, materials and other personal property set forth therein. This amendment will also include a reference to new Oakland Municipal Code, Chapter 2.05, which will govern the purchase, sale and disposal of the City's museum collections maintained by the Oakland Museum of California.
