INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER President IGNACIO DE LA FUENTE

A RESOLUTION IMMEDIATELY ALLOCATING \$3,636 FROM THE PRIORITY PROJECT FUNDS OF CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT IGNACIO DE LA FUENTE TO “THE CRUCIBLE” FOR A NINE WEEK WORKSHOP FOR EDNA BREWER MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS FOR THE CREATION OF 30 METAL FLOWERS AS PART OF A SCHOOL BEAUTIFICATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, on June 8, 2006, the City Council amended the 2005-2007 Policy Budget for the City of Oakland to include \$250,000 for each Councilmember’s priority projects, subject to approval by the full City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Parent Teacher Association (PTA) of Edna Brewer Middle school in collaboration with school administrators have engaged the students in various school beautification projects; and

WHEREAS, students will participate in a nine week workshop at The Crucible where they will learn introductory skills to welding, torch cutting and blacksmithing; and

WHEREAS, student will create 30 metal flowers which will be permanently displayed on their school campus; and

WHEREAS, City Council President Ignacio De La Fuente supports the efforts of the Edna Brewer PTA and this project; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the City Council immediately allocates \$3,636 from the priority project funds of City Council President Ignacio De La Fuente to “The Crucible” for a nine week workshop for Edna Brewer Middle School students for the creation of 30 metal flowers as part of a school beautification project.
