Re: A Resolution Authorizing An Immediate Grant of \$15,000 From Councilmember Pat Kernighan's Priority Project Funds and \$5,000 From Councilmember Nancy Nadel's Priority Project Funds For Operating Expenses to the Intertribal Friendship House, A Non-Profit Organization That Promotes an Understanding of the Presence and Contribution of American Indian people in the Bay Area.

SUMMARY

Each Councilmember has been allocated \$250,000 in Councilmember Priority Funds as one of the amendments to the Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Mid-Cycle Budget. Councilmember Kernighan would like to allocate \$15,000 of District 2 Priority funds and Councilmember would like to allocate \$5,000 in District 3 Priority funds to the Intertribal Friendship House.

FISCAL IMPACT

The \$250,000 Priority Project Funds for each Councilmember are in the Mid-Cycle Budget that was approved at the June 8, 2006 City Council Special Session. Releasing these funds will have no negative impact on this Budget.

BACKGROUND

During discussions of the 2006-2007 Mid-Cycle Budget, Councilmembers requested funds for projects and/or institutions they considered worthy of support. To accommodate these requests, the Council allocated \$2 million dollars, or \$250,000 to each Council District plus the At Large seat. The allocation of these funds is to be made at the discretion of each individual councilmember, subject to City Council approval.

DISCUSSION

Intertribal Friendship House, a non-profit 501 (C) (3) established in 1955, operates an American Indian Center in Oakland responding to the needs of American Indian people of many tribes who had migrated into the area through the Federal relocation program. The Intertribal Friendship House also provides future generations of American Indians with a place where they can learn about their culture and way of life.
