## RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt the following resolutions:

- 1) Resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee to award and execute a construction contract to Gordon N. Ball, Inc., the lowest responsive and responsible bidder in accordance with project plans and specifications for the Lake Merritt Sail Boat House Shoreline Improvement (Project No. C393710) and with contractor's bid in the amount of Five Million Five Hundred Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$5,515,000); and
- 2) Resolution authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee to apply for, accept and appropriate grant funds in an amount up to Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) from the State of California Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways for the Lake Merritt Sail Boat House Shoreline Improvement Project.

## **OUTCOME**

Approving these resolutions will authorize the City Administrator or his designee to award and execute a construction contract in the amount of \$5,515,000 for the construction of the Project and to apply for, accept and appropriate up to \$500,000 in grant funds for the Project.

## BACKGROUND/LEGISLATIVE HISTORY

The Project is funded through Measure DD, the Oakland Trust for Clean Water and Safe Parks, a \$198,250,000 general obligation bond measure passed by Oakland voters in November 2002. The bond provides funds for construction projects related to parks and clean water in five categories:

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- Lake Merritt and Water Quality Improvements
- Estuary Waterfront Access, Parks and Clean-up
- Lake Merritt to Estuary Connection Channel
- Youth and Public Recreation Facilities
- Creeks and Waterways Restoration

Funding for the project is available in Measure DD Bond Series 2009B under Resolution 84914 C.M.S, passed by Council on April 1, 2014 and Series 2015C which will be issued in early 2015.

The proposed project, identified under Measure DD - Lake Merritt and Water Quality Improvements category, consists of the demolition and renovation of deteriorating shoreline to create a new tidal marsh; pathways; repair of the existing failing bulkheads; construction of a new plaza; reorientation of the boat launch ramp for improved boat access, parking, irrigation and landscaping, lighting, site furniture and gangways to meet the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) for Boating programs. See *Attachment A:* Project Site Plan for site location.

Because the scope of work includes areas both in and adjacent to a water body, Lake Merritt, permits from the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACOE), California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) and the California State Regional Water Quality Board (SRWQB) are required. The contractor must implement monitoring methods including noise monitoring, vibration monitoring, consulting with a biologist and methods of construction to limit pollutants and disturbance of soil within Lake Merritt. Further, a five-year plant establishment period is required to ensure plant survival and habitat formation.

#### **ANALYSIS**

### **Project Bids:**

The Project was advertised on February 20, 2014. On March 13, 2014, the City Clerk received 3 bids for the project as shown below and on *Attachment B*: Bid Results (March 13, 2014).

Contract Compliance deemed Gordon N. Ball as the lowest, responsive and responsible bidder. ProVen Management was deemed non-responsive to the Small/Local Business Enterprise (S/LBE) Program as shown on *Attachment C:* Contract Compliance Bid Analysis (March 27, 2014). Sufficient funds are available for the lowest bid from Measure DD Bond Series 2009B and 2015C. The engineer's estimate is \$5,000,000 for the project. The lowest bid is \$5,515,000.

The contract bid price includes a \$500,000 allowance for construction contingency that will allow for unforeseen conditions and other work as required to complete the project scope.

## **Grant Application:**

To leverage Measure DD funds and to supplement project funding, staff applied for \$500,000 from the State of California Department of Parks & Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) Non-Motorized Boating Facility Grant on April 1, 2014. DBW anticipates informing applicants by June 1, 2014 for funding in the State's 2014-15 fiscal year. If the grant is awarded, a new project and fund appropriation will be established at that time.

## **Project Schedule:**

Because of the concentrated bird populations within the vicinity (Bird Island in Lake Merritt and trees within Lakeside Park), CDFW does not allow sustained loud noise or vibration to occur during bird nesting season which runs from February 15 through August 15. The Notice to Proceed must be issued as close to August 1, 2014 as possible to allow sufficient time for the contractor to mobilize.

The contract specifies \$2,500 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 130 working days. Construction is anticipated to begin in August 2014 and complete by May 2015.

## PUBLIC OUTREACH/INTEREST

Public outreach for Measure DD is conducted through the Measure DD Community Coalition. The DD Coalition was formed to establish an ongoing dialogue between the City of Oakland and the community on how the bond measure is being implemented. The group meets bi-monthly and provides regular updates to the public through the Measure DD website. The project has been presented by the DD Program Manager and Project Management staff at eight Measure DD meetings since November 2011. Measure DD Coalition meeting minutes are posted on the Coalition website and distributed to the Coalition mailing list. Additionally, the project description, schematic plans and project updates have been posted on the City's Measure DD website and the Waterfront Action Measure DD website pages since 2011.

Oakland Parks and Recreation staff also presented updates to the Oakland Boating Advisory Council (BAC) at their meeting on February 28, 2013. On March 19, 2013 staff received a letter and the meeting notes from the BAC expressing concerns mostly on the reduction of parking lot size, ability to maneuver boat trailers in the lot, parking lot lighting level, parking entry driveway reconfiguration, and entry plaza. City responded on March 28, 2013 to address their concerns or provide explanations for the design elements, mainly:

 The reduction of parking spaces is in accordance with the Lake Merritt Master Plan and Measure DD Bond requirement to expand the shoreline for recreation. The difference of spaces will be replaced with a modest net increase through a separate project on Bellevue

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Avenue Improvements. Additional comments on the Bellevue Avenue improvements are being addressed through the Bellevue Avenue Improvement project reviews.

- The design incorporated required dimensions for maneuvering of boat trailers and fire department vehicles.
- Lighting is improved through the replacement of old fixtures with new LED type fixtures and replacing/adding new poles.
- Driveway entry configuration provides for two-way access to replace the current confusing driveways with one-way access.
- The plaza is an addition to create a formal entry to the rented Sail Boat House, a safe gathering/programmable space for the Sailboat House entry that currently does not exist.

The project was presented to the Park & Recreation Advisory Committee Meeting on October 10, 2012. The project was also displayed at the Love Your Lake Day event in June 2013. The Project was further publicly noticed through the City's Planning and Zoning Approval Process for the Minor Conditional Use and Creek Permits in August 2013. In addition, tree removal notices for the Project were posted in July 2013 in accordance with the Tree Removal Permit process. City Planning and Tree Services staff received no appeals.

The City's design consultant and Staff met with members of the BAC on April 30, 2014 and May 5, 2014 to gather additional valuable input. A compromise was reached regarding the landscaping and parking count in the lot that still meets the Measure DD Bond intent and works with OPR programming, public safety while creating an enjoyable space for all.

<sup>\*</sup> Staff will return to Council in early 2015 for authorization to issue the series 2015C of Measure DD general obligation bonds. Series C will be in the amount \$61,927,596 and will complete the Total Bond amount of \$198,250,000. In the event that Series C is not issued prior to the completion of the project, under Resolution 84918 C.M.S. approved on April 1, 2014, staff has authority to temporarily reallocate Series B funding necessary to complete the project.

#### 4. FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of these resolutions will authorize the City Administrator or his designee to: 1) award and execute a construction contract to Gordon N. Ball, Inc. in the amount of \$5,515,000; and 2) apply for, appropriate and execute an agreement for the Grant.

The City is currently responsible for the maintenance and upkeep of the facility and landscaping areas. The responsibility will continue; however, the contractor will provide plant establishment services for a duration of 60 months.

## PAST PERFORMANCE, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW-UP

The Contractor Performance Evaluation for Gordon N. Ball, Inc. is not available. The contractor has been awarded one City contract that is currently under construction. Work is progressing satisfactorily.

## SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

*Economic*: The project will improve the public access to the Lake for educational, sporting and recreational programs, and generate economic and job opportunities for Oakland residents, provide business tax, sales tax, and other revenues for the City by those who work on the project.

*Environmental*: The contractor is required to recycle and re-use construction materials to the extent practicable and comply with City standards. The project improves the water quality by reducing the parking footprint and the creation of the bio-retention ponds on site.

**Social Equity**: The improvements will enhance public access to Lake Merritt for the public, providing an inviting plaza and site furniture and creating accessible parking and pathways to the Sail Boat House and restroom improvements.

## **CEQA**

An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the project has been completed and certified on April 1, 2008 and a Notice of Determination was filed on April 3, 2008. The State Clearinghouse is #2006122048. The EIR was titled *Measure DD Implementation Project* and included a project-level analysis of all projects funded by local bond Measure DD.


Attachment A - Location Map & Project Site Plan


