A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO OBTAIN SIGNS FOR RONALD H. COWAN PARKWAY AND OAKLAND FOREIGN TRADE ZONE, TO BE INSTALLED ALONG THE INTERSTATE 880 FREEWAY.

IRREGULAR WHEN RECEIVED

WHRREAS, The Port Of Oakland has requested the City of Oakland obtain signs indicating Ronald H. Cowan Parkway and Oakland Foreign Trade Zone from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

WHEREAS, Sections 34091.1 and 34092 of the California Government Code authorize the City Council to change the name of any exiting City street; and

WHERAS, The revitalizing efforts along the Hegenberger Road Corridor and 98th Avenue as part of the airport gateway expiations require additional signage along Interstate 880 (I880); and

WHEREAS, Caltrans is prepared to complete signage installation along I880, near he new 98th Avenue approach leading to the Oakland International Airport, with recommendations for signage including only the street portion of the over pass ramp renamed Ronald H. Cowan Parkway to adhere to the Caltrans ½ mile policy applicated signage placement, along freeways; and

WHEREAS, The Ronald H. Cowan sign will help guide through traffic to Alameda towards the new 98th Avenue approach form the freeway, thereby easing congestion on Hegenberger Road specifically, and in the area generally;

WHEREAS, The Oakland Foreign Trade Zone sign will not only indicate is location, but also remind passers-by of the important role the City Of Oakland plays in the nation's international trade infrastructure.
