## A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S REAPPOINTMENT OF CATHY EBERHARDT AND APPOINTMENT OF LINDA ST. JULIAN AND MOHAMAD ANWAR BAROUDI TO THE COMMISSION ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

**WHEREAS,** Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 9968 C.M.S., adopted August 5, 1980, and amended by Ordinance No. 11864 C.M.S., adopted March 12, 1996 and then by Ordinance No. 13334 C.M.S., adopted October 20, 2015, created the Commission on Persons with Disabilities to address issues germane to accessibility, services and civil rights for persons with disabilities; and

**WHEREAS,** the Commission on Persons with Disabilities consists of eleven (11) members, serving three-year staggered terms with no more than two consecutive terms; and

**WHEREAS,** at least a majority of the Commission members appointed must be persons with disabilities; and

**WHEREAS,** the Honorable Mayor Sheng Thao has reappointed Cathy Eberhardt to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities, subject to confirmation by the City Council; and

**WHEREAS,** the Honorable Mayor Sheng Thao has appointed Linda St. Julian and Mohamad Anwar Baroudi to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That pursuant to City Charter Section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointments to the Commission on Persons with Disabilities:

**Cathy Eberhardt,** to serve a three-year term beginning on September 3, 2023 and ending September 2, 2026, filling a seat previously held by herself.

**Mohamad Anwar Baroudi**, to serve a three-year term beginning on October 9, 2023 and ending October 8, 2026, filling a seat previously held by Steven Lau.

Linda St. Julian, to serve a three-year term that began on September 3, 2021 and ending September 2, 2024, filling a seat previously held by Karen Nakamura.
