RESOLUTION ORDERING THE MAKING OF AMENDED REASSESSMENTS PURSUANT TO PART 10 OF DIVISION 10 OF THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE AND DIRECTING ACTIONS WITH RESPECT THERETO FIRE AREA REASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 99-1

**RESOLVED,** by the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California, that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913 and Resolution of Intention No. 69877, adopted by this Council on March 23, 1993 and pursuant to the Refunding Act of 1984 for 1915 Improvement Act Bonds and Resolution No. 75100 C.M.S. adopted by this Council on June 29, 1999, special reassessments were confirmed to pay the costs of the acquisitions and improvements as more particularly described in said Resolution. Said Reassessments are set forth on a Reassessment Diagram and Reassessment Roll, heretofore confirmed by this Council and filed and recorded with the City Clerk of the City of Oakland and the County of Alameda; and

WHEREAS, certain parcels of land designated as Reassessment Numbers 13, 1882G, 1882H, 889, 890, and 891 upon which there are unpaid Reassessments where bonds have been issued under the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, commencing with Section 8500 of the Street and Highways Code of California, have been reconfigured so that they no longer conform to the original parcel boundaries as shown on said Reassessment Diagram;

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

The Superintendent of Streets of the City of Oakland shall cause to be filed with the City Clerk the Reassessment Apportionment Reports, an Amended Reassessment Diagram and Amended Reassessment Roll of Reassessment Numbers 13, 1882G, 1882H, 889, 890, and 891, which were previously recorded on the 23rd day of July 1999 in Book 13, Pages 54-89, Document No. 99-273545, segregating and apportioning the unpaid installments of the original Reassessments in accordance with the benefits to the several parts of the original parcel.
