

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff recommends Council approval of a resolution authorizing the City Manager to award a construction contract to Gallagher and Burk, Inc. for Rehabilitation of Certain Streets in the City of Oakland by the Overlay Method between the Dates of September 1, 2003 and August 31, 2004 in the amount of \$1,241,832.40 (Project No. C17180).

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimate for the construction work is \$1,463,364 and the construction contract will be in the amount of \$1,241,832.40. Funding comes from the Municipal Capital Improvement Fund and State Traffic Congestion Relief Funds. Funding for the MacArthur Bike Lane portion of the project comes from a Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) Grant. The estimated cost for this part of the project is \$61,497 (this cost is included in the total estimate). Sufficient funds are available for the construction work in the following three project accounts:

#### **SUMMARY**

Staff recommends Council approval of a resolution authorizing the City Manager to award a construction contract to Gallagher and Burk, Inc. for Rehabilitation of Certain Streets in the City of Oakland by the Overlay Method between the Dates of September 1, 2003 and August 31, 2004 in the amount of \$1,241,832.40 (Project No. C17180).

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimate for the construction work is \$1,463,364 and the construction contract will be in the amount of \$1,241,832.40. Funding comes from the Municipal Capital Improvement Fund and State Traffic Congestion Relief Funds. Funding for the MacArthur Bike Lane portion of the project comes from a Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) Grant. The estimated cost for this part of the project is \$61,497 (this cost is included in the total estimate). Sufficient funds are available for the construction work in the following three project accounts:

#### **BACKGROUND**

On August 25, 2003, the City Clerk received three bids for the project as shown on *Attachment A*. The project consists of the resurfacing of approximately 7.9 centerline miles of streets. The streets scheduled to be resurfaced are shown on *Attachment B*.

#### **KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS**

Construction work is scheduled to begin in November 2003 and will be completed by October 2004. The contract specifies \$425 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contractor exceeds the contract completion time of 260 working days. The project schedule is shown on *Attachment A*.

The low bidder has met all the City's local trucking program requirements. For the low bidder, the SLBE participation in 23.69% and the LBE participation is 15%. The total LBE/SLBE participation level is 38.69%. While these participation levels do not meet the requirements they are the highest levels from all bidders. The LBE/SLBE information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Manager's Office and is shown in *Attachment C*.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

**Economic:** All public works contracts require prevailing rate of wages. The low bidder has a LBE participation level of 15% and a SLBE participation level of 23.69%. The low bidder has a local trucking participation level of 100%, which meets the City's participation goals.

Environmental: New asphalt pavement contains as much as 15% recycled asphalt. A portion of this project is dedicated to creating a new bike lane on Macarthur Boulevard between Lakeshore and Park. Bike lanes encourage a more active lifestyle and promote the use of alternative transportation and reduce pollution due to automobile use.

<u>Social Equality:</u> Resurfacing of streets is based on street condition and ranking by City's Pavement Management System (PMS).

#### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Street resurfacing will eliminate potholes and provide a uniform travel surface for pedestrians using crosswalks.

#### RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the City Manager be authorized to award the construction contract to Gallagher and Burk, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,241,832.40. While Gallagher and Burk, Inc. have not met the City's LBE/SLBE program requirements they have the highest percentages of all the bidders. Gallagher and Burk, Inc. has met the local trucking requirements and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

#### ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.


