INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBERS TREVA REID

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AB 2064 (JONES-SAWYER, R.) WHICH WOULD ESTABLISH THE COMMUNITY VIOLENCE INTERDICTION GRANT PROGRAM UNDER THE CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY. IT AIMS TO FUND LOCAL COMMUNITY PROGRAMS ADDRESSING VIOLENCE IN NEIGHBORHOODS AND SCHOOLS. THE BILL DIRECTS FUNDING TOWARDS RECREATION AND HEALTH-BASED YOUTH INTERVENTIONS AND THE CREATION OF SCHOOL-BASED HEALTH CENTERS

- **WHEREAS**, AB 2064, as amended, Jones-Sawyer, R., addresses the urgent need to reduce violence in California communities through targeted interventions; and
- **WHEREAS**, the bill aims to establish the Community Violence Interdiction Grant Program within the California Health and Human Services Agency; and
- **WHEREAS**, AB 2064 seeks to provide funding to local community programs that offer community-driven solutions to decrease violence in neighborhoods and schools; and
- **WHEREAS**, the bill emphasizes the importance of recreation- and health-based interventions for youth during peak times of violence; and
- **WHEREAS**, AB 2064 supports the creation and operation of school-based health centers as part of comprehensive violence reduction strategies; and
- **WHEREAS**, the establishment of the Community Violence Interdiction Grant Program aligns with efforts to enhance public safety and promote community well-being in California; and
- **WHEREAS**, the bill mandates the California Health and Human Services Agency to develop an application process and criteria for funding under the grant program; and
- **WHEREAS**, AB 2064 requires annual reporting on the savings to the state resulting from the closure of state prisons, ensuring transparency and accountability in resource allocation; and

RESOLVED that the City Council supports AB 2064 (Jones-Sawyer) in the California legislature; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the City Council directs the City Administrator or his designee to immediately distribute this resolution upon its adoption to Governor Gavin Newsom and California State Representative Reggie Jones-Sawyer.
