RESOLUTION No. _____ C.M.S.

Resolution In Support of Senate Bill 1545 (DeSaulnier) that Would Prohibit Public Money from being used on the Development or Improvement of an Office Building at 390 Main Street, San Francisco, Until After The State Auditor has Completed a Specified Audit Relating to The Move of the Headquarters of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission.

WHEREAS, Existing law designates that the Metropolitan Transportation Commission as the regional transportation planning agency for the 9-county San Francisco Bay Area creates the Bay Area Toll Authority with specified powers and duties relative to administration of certain toll revenues from state-owned toll bridges within the geographic jurisdiction of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1545 would prohibit public money from being used on the development or improvement of an office building at 390 Main Street, San Francisco, until after the State Auditor has completed a specified audit relating to the move of the headquarters of the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and upon completion of the audit, the bill would require the issues raised in the audit to be addressed and a report in that regard to be submitted to the Legislature prior to future expenditure of public money on the headquarters project, and these provisions would apply to the Bay Area Toll Authority, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, and the Bay Area Headquarters Authority.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1545 Bill would thereby impose a state-mandated local program, and The California Constitution requires the state to reimburse local agencies and school districts for certain costs mandated by the state, and statutory provisions establish procedures for making that reimbursement, so be it

RESOLVED: That the Council of the City of Oakland proclaims its support for California Senate Bill 1545 (DeSaulnier) and authorizes the City Administrator to instruct the Legislative Lobbyist for the City to support the passage of Senate Bill 1545.
