**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE DOLLARS (\$29,973) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, TO THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GANG RESISTANCE EDUCATION AND TRAINING (GREAT) PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, grant funds in the amount of \$29,973 have been awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, for continued instruction of the Gang Resistance Education and Training (GREAT) program by the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, these federal grant funds are earmarked to provide gang resistance education for students in 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade at Cole, Frick and Havenscourt Middle Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the GREAT program will assist in the Police Department's goal of decreasing incidents of youth-based violence and other delinquent activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar grant funds by Resolution No. 77698 C.M.S. dated March 18, 2003, and Resolution No. 77013 C.M.S. dated March 12, 2002; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept \$29,973 in grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs and to increase revenues and appropriate said budget to the Police Department; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That grant funds shall be maintained in the Federal Grant Fund: 2112; Campus Life And School Safety (CLASS) Org.: 105530; Youth and Community Services Program PS04; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award.
