




Disparity Study Recommendations



New Enhanced Social Justice Policies for Oakland Residents and Businesses!





<u>50% IL/SILBE PARTICIPATION</u> -Oakland City Council will increase the level of business participation in City contracting from 20% to 50% or from 10% local and 10% small local to 25% local and 25% small local. An increase of 15%.

25% Local and 25% Small Local Split to meet minimum requirement

SLBE participation counts as full credit

Locally Produced
Goods earn value equal
to SLBE preferences &
bid discounts

50% Business Participation LBE counts as ½ value and must be equally paired with SLBE

Very small earns twice the preference points and bid discounts (up to 5%)

25% LBE and 25% SLBE Split to meet minimum requirement

A&E = minimum 50% L/SLBE






* WHAT ARE PREFERENCE POINTS and BID DISCOUNTS? Actions designed to stimulate the local economy by affording preferences and discounts for local business participation. They apply to proposals and bids when the City conducts a competitive Request for Proposal (RFP), Request for Qualifications (RFQ) or Notice Inviting Bids (NIB) process in order to buy professional and construction services or commodities.



- ❖ <u>Preference Points</u> are additional points earned for meeting certain pre-defined conditions in the *Request For Proposal* (RFP) process ONLY.
 - ✓ During the RFP process additional points may be awarded during the <u>evaluation phase</u> of the Request for Proposal (RFP) process.
 - ✓ Preference points are added to the total technical score (usually totaling 100 points) for meeting certain criteria as defined by the City in the RFP document.
- Bid Discounts represent a reduced value for the sake of increasing L/SLBE participation. Bid Discounts are applied during the Notice Inviting Bids (NIB) process and when Purchasing Services solicits quotes. Bids may be discounted up to 5% of the total bid amount.

- 1. \$250,000 contracts
- 2. Solicit from pre-qualified pool of Oakland certified SLBE bidders
- 3. Issue Notice Inviting Bids.
- 4. Lowest Responsible and Responsive bidder prevails.
- 5. Evaluate minimum qualifications and create a list of L/SLBE bidders.
- 6. Three responsive bids must be received.
- 7. Default to open market where current policies apply.

OUALIFICATIONS BASED

- 1. \$250,000 contracts
- 2. Solicit from pre-qualified pool of Oakland certified SLBE proposers
- 3. Request submittal of required qualifications.
- 4. Three responsive proposals must be received.
- 5. Default to open market where current policies apply.
