INTRODUCED BY COUNC	CILMEMBER ABEL GUILLÉN

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000 FROM COUNCILMEMBER ABEL GUILLÉN'S GRAFFITI ABATEMENT MURAL AND GREEN WALL FUNDS TO THE TIDES CENTER FOR USE BY THE HOPE COLLABORATIVE FOR A MURAL AT THREE AMIGOS MARKET ON 1554 13<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE IN DISTRICT 2

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the City Council adopted a budget that set aside Graffiti Abatement Funds for Murals and Green Walls for the Oakland City Councilmembers to award at their discretion, subject to Council approval, in an effort to address graffiti within their districts; and

**WHEREAS**, graffiti is and has been a major source of blight in District 2 including on the site of Three Amigos Market on 155413<sup>th</sup> Avenue, which is located two blocks from Franklin Elementary School and is a destination for many students and their families; and

WHEREAS, HOPE Collaborative is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, with the goal of transforming this retailer into an oasis of healthy food options including fresh deli, healthier snacks and fresh produce options for Oakland residents; and

**WHEREAS**, HOPE Collaborative will collaborate with local artist Jose "Peps" Garcia from the East Side Arts Alliance and engage the community in the development and implementation of the mural through workshops, feedback sessions and community painting sessions; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Abel Guillén wishes to grant a portion of his Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall Funds to the Tides Center, a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation, for use by the HOPE Collaborative, on a mural on the exterior of Three Amigos Market on 1554 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue in District 2; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements, HOPE Collaborative will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall Funds, including any permits required and permission from the property owner to install this mural; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council authorizes a grant not to exceed \$10,000 from Councilmember Abel Guillén's Graffiti Abatement Mural and Green Wall Funds to the Tides Center for use by HOPE Collaborative for the mural at Three Amigos Market, located at 1554 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue in District 2; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is authorized to execute a grant agreement with HOPE Collaborative for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
