

INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER DAN KALB

RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING ANNALEE ALLEN ON HER RETIREMENT AND THANKING HER FOR HER EXEMPLARY SERVICE TO THE CITY AND PEOPLE OF OAKLAND

WHEREAS, Annalee, an Oakland/Rockridge resident for more than 40 years, committed to giving back to the Oakland in her long history of leadership around historic preservation; and

WHEREAS, Annalee has been the Oakland Tours Coordinator, first in the Redevelopment Agency, then Community & Economic Development Agency (CEDA) and now the Economic and Workforce Development Department; and

WHEREAS, since 1996 Annalee has coordinated with Oakland Unified School District third grade classrooms for civic tours, the Mayor and City Council Offices on special tours, and has recruited, trained and supported a group of volunteer tour guides on public tours; and

WHEREAS, Annalee has served as "Ms. Oakland History" for many inquiries to the City on historic questions and information; and

WHEREAS, Annalee is the past president of the Oakland Heritage Alliance, Past City of Oakland Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board Member, past Member of the Pardee Home and other historic houses including Peralta Historical Hacienda and Dunsmuir-Hellman House; and

WHEREAS, Annalee's dedication to maintaining open doors, treating everyone with warmth and offering a wealth of historical knowledge has put DeFremery Recreation Center on the map as a destination center for all of Oakland; and

WHEREAS, Annalee is a current Alameda County Parks, Recreational and Historical Commission member, appointed by Supervisor Nate Miley; and

WHEREAS, Annalee is now retiring from the City to spend time with her family and continue her good work on behalf of Oakland offering warm hospitality; now, therefore, be it


